Thatcher gets tea invitation

DALLAS (AP) — Mark Thatcher's new neighbors, dubbed "terrified Texans" in the British press, say there is little support for a move to evict the British prime minister's son — and some would even like to invite him to tea.

The assistant manager of the condominium complex where Thatcher recently moved said most residents don't appear to agree with a memo circulated last week by one neighbor who said Thatcher should be forced out because he was a terrorist target.

Ruby Beene said Wednesday, "Most of it's the other way. They would like to invite him to tea."

She later amended that: "They said if he's here, they want to invite him to tea."

Beene said she couldn't verify that Thatcher, 32, actually lives in the luxury high-rise on a tree-lined street that includes other apartment buildings and offices.

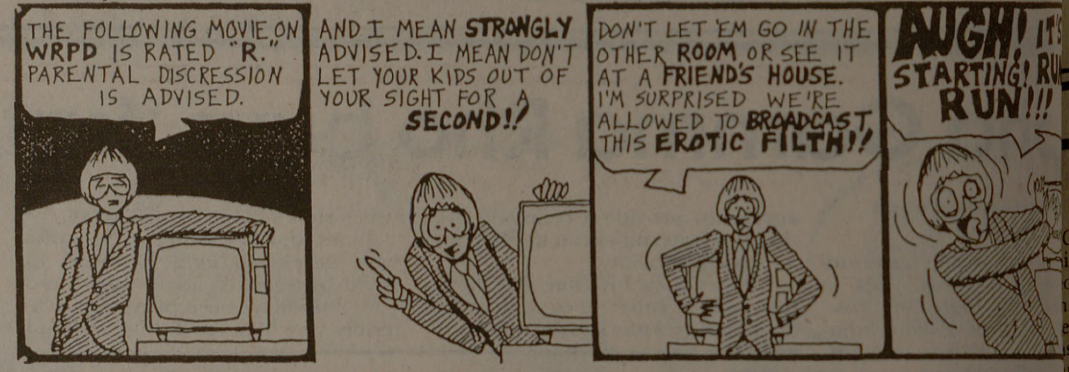
"We have nothing official," she said.

Thatcher was evicted from one Dallas apartment when his landlords said they couldn't protect him from terrorist threats that followed the U.S. bombing of Libya on April 15. His mother, Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher, supported the United States.

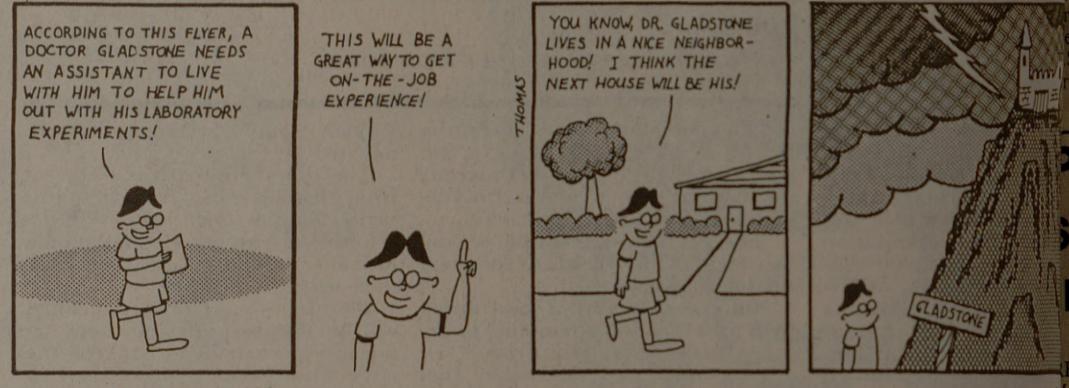
News of the memo at the new building prompted former Sen. John Tower to say the fearful resident made Texans look like "a bunch of yellow-bellies."

Comptroller: Recession to stay until '88

AUSTIN (AP) — Texans will remember the recession of 1986 as being almost as bad as the recession of 1983, Comptroller Bob Bullock says.

Times will begin to get better in 1988 but the improvement will be slow, Bullock said in his latest economic forecast Thursday.

"Despite the smaller economic role played by oil and gas, falling energy prices will hurt the state almost as much as they did in 1983 because oil prices fell further and faster this time," he said.

Bullock said his overall forecast is that Texas will underperform the national economy through 1987 as it has done since 1984.

"In 1988, Texas will catch up to the U.S. economic growth and begin to outperform the national economy as oil prices stabilize and drilling activity picks up," Bullock predicted.

Bullock's forecast said Texas will lose 55,000 nonfarm jobs this year — fewer than in 1983 when falling oil prices cost the state 72,000 jobs.

He said the decline in jobs would

be confined to 1986, but there would be little improvement in 1987.

The energy industry will lose 46,700 jobs in 1986, he said.

Manufacturing will lose 33,300 jobs in 1986, he predicted, then will continue to grow at a rate of two to three percent in 1987 and 1988.

Construction employment is expected to decline by 4,200 jobs in 1986 and by 8,100 in 1987. A moderate rebound is expected in 1988.

"Since the end of the recession in 1983, about 87 percent of the new

jobs in Texas have been in government and service businesses," Bullock said.

The recession of 1986 will be as bad as the recession of 1983, he said.

The comptroller predicts unemployment will increase 7.5 percent in the first quarter of 1986 to 8.4 percent in the first quarter of 1987.

He estimated the population of Texas will exceed the number moving into the state in 1986.
