


Treasurer: State needs money now, not later

AUSTIN (AP) - State Treasurer Ann Richards said Wednesday unless the current special legislative session enacts new revenue measures, the state will not be able to

honor its checks by September 1987.
"A program of budget cuts solves the cash-flow problem only temporarily until August 1987 and delaying revenue measures until January will be too late," Richards told the Senate Finance Committee.

"If the Legislature fails to bring in new revenue during this special session . . . we will begin the biennium so deep in the cash hole that we won't be able to borrow or beg enough money to meet our daily cash needs," she said.
