

Injury sidelines track star Lewis

BERLIN (AP) — Sprinter and long jumper Carl Lewis, a day after finishing a disappointing third in a 100-meter race, said Thursday that a knee injury that has troubled him for more than two months will sideline him until February.

"I'm finished for the year," said Lewis. "I'll be back next year, no doubt."

Lewis, who won four gold medals at the Los Angeles Olympics, finished third to Canada's Ben Johnson Wednesday night at a Mobil Grand Prix meet in Zurich, Switzerland.

Johnson turned in a time of 10.03 seconds, easily outdistancing Lewis, who was clocked in 10.25. Nigeria's Chidi Imoh was second in 10.23.

Lewis has been experiencing pain from a stretched tendon in his left knee since The Athletics Congress outdoor championship meet last June at Eugene, Ore.

anteed contract on Wednesday.

Asked if he would renegotiate Dorsett's contract, Schramm replied, "I feel comfortable with his contract."

Dorsett had originally welcomed the thought of playing in the same backfield with another Heisman Trophy winner, but was steamed

when details of Walker's contract came out.

"If this team does not pay me like they are paying their other back, I would suggest strongly that the team try to trade me or pay me because I'll be very unhappy and . . . I can be a very disruptive force," Dorsett said.

"I don't want to be here. When you pay a guy more than me, you've

told me he's your back. I'm not second fiddle to anyone."

Schramm said he can remember grumbling among the Cowboys' players when Dorsett was signed in 1977.

Walker, 24, the 1982 Heisman Trophy winner, set a professional football rushing record for one sea-

son with 2,411 yards for the USFL New Jersey Generals in 1985.

Defensive tackle Randy White said he didn't mind Walker making more than he does.

"You don't get mad because somebody else gets a better deal," White said. "I was happy when I signed my contract two years ago and I'm still happy. Besides, I think Herschel can help us get back to the Super Bowl."

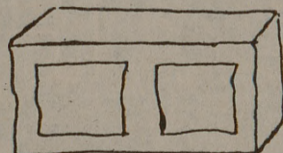

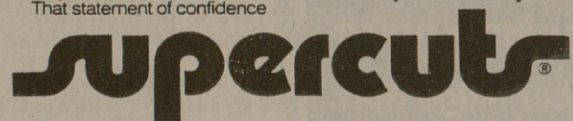

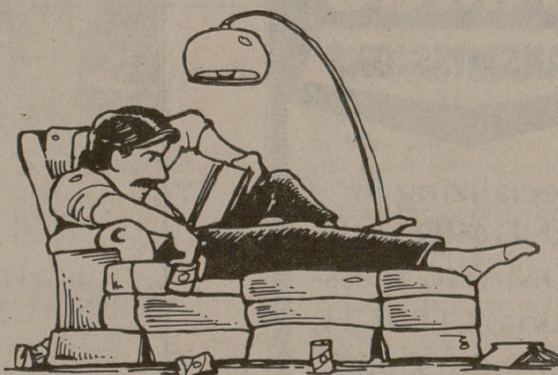
