



# Prison escapees, Wh... hostage at largest stil... search continues re...

HOUSTON (AP) — The wherea-  
abouts of two Louisiana prison escapees  
and a woman hostage are still un-  
known, although authorities suspect  
the convicts may be trying to reach  
Mexico, police said Tuesday.

"They haven't been caught and  
there's not much of any new infor-  
mation," Houston police Sgt. M.E.  
Doyle said.

The search for Danny Weeks, 33,  
and James Colvin, 32, began after  
the two and a third inmate were dis-  
covered missing Saturday night at  
the Louisiana Penitentiary at An-  
gola, Warden Frank Blackburn said.

Weeks, who has broken out of jail  
twice previously, and Colvin forced  
Linda Mayeax, 38, into her car at  
knifepoint as she sat in the parking  
lot of St. Frances Cabrini Hospital in  
Alexandria, La. at about 9:30 a.m.  
Sunday, said Houston police Sgt. Bill  
Stephens.

About eight hours later, she was  
freed unharmed in Houston. The  
two escapees then forced Karyn Lac-  
cheo, 29, an Army lieutenant on  
leave, to drive the pair, with  
told police. The convicts and  
hostage were believed to be  
woman's 1986 Toyota Celica.

Police said they took the  
left Houston and were aiming  
Mexico, where Weeks, who is  
fluent Spanish, has lived in the  
past.

Police said Mayeax told the  
pair was armed with a 38-  
gun. Authorities were not  
how the inmates escaped  
prison, but they apparently  
the Mississippi River by float-  
ing log.

Colvin, of the Shreveport  
was serving an 80-year sentence  
armed robbery. Weeks, of  
La., was serving life plus 99  
armed robbery. He also was  
victim of second-degree murder.

The third inmate, Robert L.  
50, of Kansas City, was serving  
years. The warden said Down-  
not have made it across the

# Search continues for Lat... six Tennessee inmates

MANCHESTER, Tenn. (AP) —  
Six men, including four Texans,  
who escaped while being extradited  
to face charges in six different cities  
remained at large Tuesday, accord-  
ing to a spokesman for the firm  
transporting the inmates.

The six were being held by Extradition  
Corporation of America at the  
old Coffee County jail, which the  
firm operates as a holding facility for  
prisoners in transit, said spokesman  
Dick Baumbach.

Coffee County Sheriff Bobby Mc-  
Cullough said escape warrants were  
issued for the missing inmates, who  
escaped Sunday night.

The inmates used a piece of metal  
reinforcing bar to pry a metal hasp  
and lock from a steel door at the old  
jail, said Manchester Police Capt.  
Bob Bellamy. Four inmates who  
stayed behind told police that they  
guard for the private company  
asleep during the escape.

One of the six, Alberto Garcia,  
was picked up by Manchester police  
after the escape, but later released  
because officers could not find his  
listed in the National Crime Identifi-  
cation Center Computer, Baumbach  
said.

The five other escapees were  
identified as Milton Benjamin, 36,  
also known as Steve Day; Dick  
Winkler, 27; James DuBois, 26;  
Mark A. Baldwin, 26; and Mike  
A. Alderson, 25.

Officials of the Manchester  
company said no more of their pris-  
oners will be confined at the jail  
until a new facility is completed  
and certified by the state, Baumbach  
said.

# Babysitter, 45, is charged in death of 2-year-old girl

FORT WORTH (AP) — A baby  
sitter who said she would give her  
life to save a child was charged Tues-  
day with murder in the apparent  
beating death of a 2-year-old girl left  
in her care, officials said.

Sheila Arthur, 45, was freed after  
posting a \$25,000 bond in the death  
of Anna Smith, who died Sunday in  
a Fort Worth hospital, Assistant Dis-  
trict Attorney Bob Marshall said.

Arthur denies harming the child  
and said the girl was hurt Friday af-  
ternoon when her older sister, Ra-  
chel, 3, pushed her off a couch while  
Arthur was in another room.

She told the Fort Worth-Star  
Telegram the child must have hit  
her head on the edge of a nearby  
television set or a metal toy.

"I wish it was me that was dead in-  
stead of that baby," Arthur, who has  
no children of her own, said. "I  
wouldn't hurt a child for anything —  
I'd give my life for one in a minute."

Tarrant County Medical Exam-  
iner Nizam Peerwani called Arthur's  
explanation ludicrous and said the  
child died from massive injuries to

both sides of her head. He said  
injuries indicate that the head  
swung sideways and struck on a  
stationary object, such as a wall  
floor.


He said he believes Anna died  
result of a beating, and he has  
the death a homicide.

Anna, the daughter of David  
Karen Smith, was hospitalized in a  
pediatric intensive care ward at  
Cook-Fort Worth Children's Mem-  
orial Hospital for two days before  
died Sunday at about 6:15 p.m.

Arthur was arrested the same  
day and held until her husband, Charles  
Arthur, posted bond for her release  
Monday.

Arthur said that for nearly 20  
years she has been licensed to op-  
erate a baby-sitting service out of  
Fort Worth home and that she  
cared for the Smith sisters for  
two years.

"I've never beaten a child in  
my life," she said. "I love children  
much. . . I did not hurt the  
child. This is being all built up that  
murderer."
