Examiners board chairman gets Optometry Board nominees rejected at White's request

AUSTIN (AP) — The Senate on Wednesday approved the appointment of Dr. Carlos Godinez of McAllen to the State Board of Medical Examiners but returned to Gov. Mark White — at his request — an appointment to the Texas Optometry Board.

Sen. John Leedom, R-Dallas, said if White had not withdrawn the appointment of Kenneth Schorr of Dallas, he would have asked his colleagues to reject the nomination as a courtesy to Leedom.

"I don't even know the gentleman," Leedom said. But he said the Texas Optometric Association had taken a "hard position" against Schorr and he was abiding by the association's wishes.

Godinez, board chairman, was one of eight board appointees who have defended themselves in recent weeks from claims by legislators and others that they were doing a poor job policing the medical profession.

Godinez said on Aug. 19, when he appeared before the Senate Nominations Committee, that the 15-member board had handled 669 complaints in 1985 and 271 disciplinary actions were taken. He was not present Wednesday when the committee, then the full Senate, approved his appointment.

Committee chairman Godwards, who has been critical of the board, said Wednesday, "The board has made some substantive steps in the right direction clearing up some problems that existed for a long time."

"I'd like to say I know Dr. Godinez has been on the receiving end of a great deal of questioning because he is chairman of the board and served on it. I hope that it is known that those questions were designed specifically to criticize Godinez personally, and I am convinced he is making a commendable effort to move ahead with some significant changes on the board of medical examiners."

Edwards, D-Duncanville, said he intends during the next legislative session to sponsor a resolution asking the Committee on Health and Resources "to exercise oversight of the Board of Examiners."

Philanthropist's will excludes relatives, gives funds to charity

GALVESTON (AP) — Millionaire philanthropist Mary Moody Northen, whose competency once was challenged by family members, excluded relatives from her will and left most of her fortune to a charitable foundation.

Northen, who had headed 50 corporations and ran the state's third largest trust, died Aug. 25 at age 94.

Her 22-page will, filed for probate Tuesday in the Galveston County clerk's office, left most of her estate — estimated to be in excess of \$25 million — to Mary Moody Northen Inc., a charitable foundation she established in 1964.

Northen's relatives' names appear in the will.

"I am not unkindful of each and every one of my relatives," she said in her will.

"I believe that my relatives are aware of and fully appreciate the reasons that have moved me to this disposition of my property and the will said.

In 1984, nephew Robert Northen filed a lawsuit alleging his uncle was mentally incompetent because of age and should not manage the trust. A judge appointed a guardian, but also ruled she maintain her position on the trust and family businesses.

Board chairman says he'll quit if cuts not approved

DALLAS (AP) — Financially strapped Bishop College may lose its board chairman if his plans for cutting spending at the school are not approved.

Acting Chairman Comer Cotrell says he'll quit if the board doesn't agree to his recommendations at a Friday board meeting.

His plans include suspending the football program, reducing the budget by \$1 million to a total of \$5 million, cutting the number of board members from 43 to 21, and someone for fund raising.

"In the three months I've been acting chairman, I've felt frustrated that I've felt that Cotrell said Tuesday, "I just had the support to make it happen."

Bishop, a 105-year-old predominantly black college, has \$5 million in debts. It faces a cash shortage because many students aren't paying tuition up front, Cotrell said.
