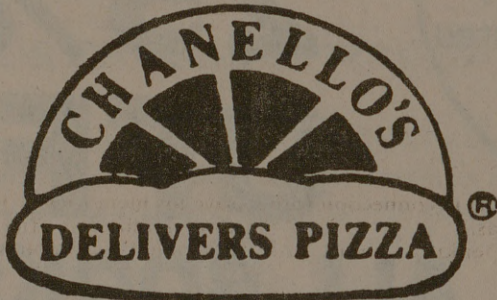

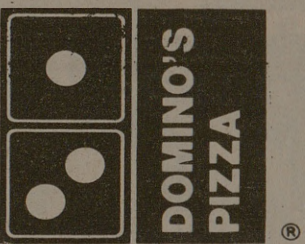

Witness: Landis planned bomb in 'Twilight Zone'

LOS ANGELES (AP) — The first witness in the "Twilight Zone" unitary manslaughter trial on Thursday that director John Landis boasted of planning to blow his movie set "off the face of the earth" with explosives.

Donna Schuman, a producer secretary, said she assumed that children hired for the movie would be exposed to intense firepower.

Schuman became emotional as prosecutor questioned why she did not believe that the children would appear in a scene featuring explosives.

"John Landis went through the place saying he was going to blow off the face of the earth," Schuman said. "You couldn't put two little in the middle of that. Whenever I heard him talk about it, he said it was going to be big, huge."

Veteran actor Vic Morrow and child actors Renee Chen, 6, and Myca Le, 7, perished under the blades of a crashing helicopter during the 1982 filming of a Vietnam War scene for "Twilight Zone: The Movie."

Landis and four others are accused of causing the deaths.

After the children had been hired, Schuman said she was told from both Landis and associate producer George Folsey, another defendant, about the possible penalties for using children in the movie without labor permits.

However, Schuman said Folsey repeatedly assured those involved with recruiting the children that they would not be placed in dangerous situations.

Defense attorney Harland Braun told the jury that the parents of the children will deny facts on the witness stand to support their \$12 million lawsuits against the moviemakers.

"We will cross-examine the parents and bring out that they are pending litigation on this issue," Braun said after a number of other remarks were stricken by the judge.

Von Bulow: settlement offer refused

PROVIDENCE, R.I. (AP) — Cosmo von Bulow said Thursday he agreed to divorce his comatose wife provided his stepchildren dropped the civil suit against him and split the inheritance with his daughter, but the offer was rejected.

The Danish-born socialite, who quit last year of twice trying to kill his heirless wife, Martha "Sunny" von Bulow, also said the offer included his renouncing of any claims on her estimated \$14 million share of her \$75 million gas and utilities fortune near Newport mansion and their other New York apartment.

"I agreed to any formula that would take me out of the picture and give Cosima her fair share, including divorce," von Bulow said in a telephone interview with The Associated Press from the Fifth Avenue apartment. "It was turned down categorically. This is confidential information. I can't discuss it more."

Alexander von Auersperg and his sister, Annie-Laurie "Ala" von Auersperg Kneissl, Mrs. von Bulow's children by a previous marriage, have fought von Bulow's efforts to reinstate Cosima von Bulow's claim to her share of the \$50 million estate left by Mrs. von Bulow's mother, late Annie Laurie Crawford Atkisson.

They also have sought to void von Bulow's interest in his wife's estate and force him to repay any money and return any property he has received from her estate since her coma in 1979.

Before Atkisson's death — and before the 1985 retrial of von Bulow that ended in his acquittal — she inherited Miss von Bulow because her granddaughter stood by her father during his four-year ordeal.

The stepchildren also have prevented their half-sister from using Clarendon Court, the palatial Newport mansion where Mrs. von Bulow twice became comatose during Christmas holiday visits.

Von Bulow said Thursday he made the settlement offer about four months ago, and received her rejection two weeks ago.

Michael Armstrong, the New York lawyer who represents the stepchildren, told WJAR-TV in Providence that the offer was turned down because of loopholes he said would have allowed Miss von Bulow to funnel money to her father.

Von Bulow, 59, on Wednesday won additional time to prepare the suit, which, like the criminal case, contends he caused his wife's comas in a bid to kill her so he could inherit her riches and marry his mistress.
