## **Authorities** seek diary of officer

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — Investigators in the shooting death of San Antonio policeman Stephen Smith were looking for a vigilante diary they think Smith may have used to record acts of vandalism and possi-

The San Antonio Light reported Thursday that the book may have been lost because the police depart-ment "failed to secure Smith's apart-ment after his death, and the officer's belongings were removed.

Smith, a seven-year veteran of the police force, was shot by fellow officer Farrell Tucker on Aug. 18.

Since then, authorities have said they are investigating whether other individuals might be involved in Smith's alleged vigilante activities.

The Bexar County grand jury investigation of the shooting case officially began Wednesday when Special Prosecutor Sid Harle obtained several subpoenaes, including those for Smith's widow and his younger brother.

The search for the diary began af-r investigators discovered that Smith used to brag to fellow officers and others about his actions.

"Smith unquestionably had a Dirty Harry complex and liked to brag about the things he did," the Light reported, quoting an unnamed source.

The newspaper said sources told it that Smith had bragged about keeping a diary of his alleged vigilante acts and those who participated




