Amoco pipeline leak linked to acrid fumes

GAINESVILLE (AP) — A leak in a buried pipeline near the Oklahoma border was blamed for acrid fumes that spread across hundreds of square miles of North Texas before dissipating Monday.

An emergency team was sent from the Environmental Protection Agency about 9:30 p.m. Sunday after law officers received a rash of calls from area residents complaining of a noxious odor, irritated eyes and breathing problems, authorities said.

A spokeswoman for Gainesville Memorial Hospital said 14 people were treated in the emergency room for poisoning symptoms and released.

Sheriff's Deputy Corkey Grundei said the smell, fanned by winds, spread more than 60 miles south to Carrollton, a suburban city just north of Dallas.

He said he first noticed a faint smell around 7 p.m.

The pipeline, located at an Amoco Oil Co. plant about five miles north of Dexter, carries condensate, a li-

quid removed from natural gas after it is processed, said Roger Meacham, a spokesman with the Environmental Protection Agency.

Dexter is about 20 miles northeast of Gainesville, near the Oklahoma border.

Amoco officials, who discovered the leak at 5:30 a.m. Monday, immediately shut down the pipeline, although some of the substances continued running into the Red River.

The pipeline runs across the Red River, which forms a portion of the Texas-Oklahoma border, and carries the condensate to a Cushing, Okla. plant where it is blended with crude oil and sent to Illinois, Craft said.

The leak is under 30 feet of water near the bank of Lake Texoma and a special diver will be needed to locate the leak and seal it, officials said.

Because citizens originally were complaining of a diesel odor, Amoco officials did not think there was a problem with the plant, Meacham said.

Cisneros volunteers for drug test

SAN ANTONIO — Mayor Henry Cisneros, drug test Monday as part of a special police officers' random checks for drug use.

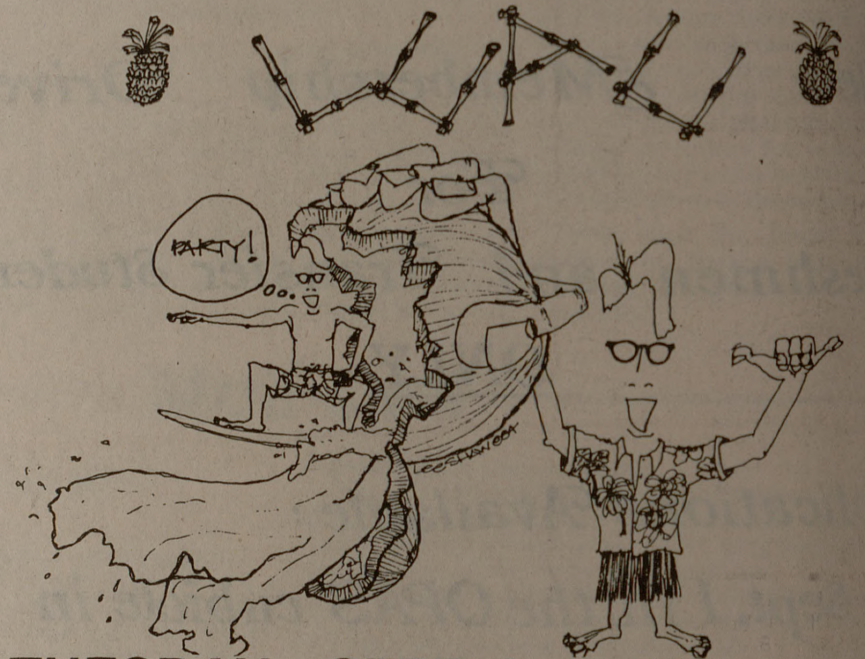
Cisneros, a member of the Texas A&M Board of Regents, said, "The drug abuse problem is so dangerous to our state that those in positions of leadership should be willing to set an example."

Cisneros agreed to the test after officials with the San Antonio Police Officers Association they favor random drug testing of officers.

Results of the mayor's test were not immediately available.

City Councilman Ed Heston said the tests would be force's 1,300 officers suffer the same rate of drug use as any other sample of 1,300 people.
