Panel identifies slain officer as gunman in 1982 killing

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — Slain police officer Stephen R. Smith apparently was the gunman in a 1982 slaying and is a suspect in two more ambush killings, a special panel of investigators has concluded.

The panel identified Smith as the killer of suspected auto burglar Terrell R. Folsom, 22, who was shot outside a San Antonio apartment on Dec. 28, 1982, police said.

Police said Smith was shot to death on Aug. 18 by fellow police officer Farrell Tucker.

Capt. James Despres said, "We will confirm that we have information which leads to the implication of Stephen Smith in three separate murders."

He said Smith is a suspect in two other homicides:

- The March 28, 1985 slaying of Clarence Leonal Cain Jr., at about 1:30 a.m.
- The Aug. 31, 1985 shooting of Adolfo Cuellar Jr., as he sat with some friends about 3:30 a.m.
