conference teams. Sherrill said the larger defensively is that A&M can't rely on the run so much that they'll be vulnerable to the pass.

Despite throwing four interceptions, Sherrill said he felt quarterback Kevin Murray had an outstanding game, who still completed 4 of 35 passes for 208 yards in the game. He added that the offensive line, a question mark at the outset of the game, played well.

But Sherrill said he expects North Texas State to play a sound zone defense Saturday and keep A&M from throwing deep.

He said he doesn't expect North Texas State, 1-0 after a 7-0 win over southwest Texas on Sept. 6, to be a pushover. Last year the Mean Green played several teams tough. They lost to Oklahoma State 10-9, TCU 4-10 and Northeast Louisiana 18-7.

In a telephone hookup, North Texas State head coach Corky Nelson said he was impressed with the Aggies while watching the A&M-LSU game.

"I had ESPN on loud and clear," Nelson said. "I turned the set off after that first drive (a 10-play touchdown drive) the Aggies had."

He said he felt the Aggies were a balanced and highly explosive offensive team and was worried about facing such a talented team coming off loss.

"I think that they're mad as hell about losing," Nelson said.

When asked about how he com-



pared the two teams, Nelson replied, "Kind of like David and Goliath without a slingshot."

"(The North Texas State players) may be living in fear of them, but they won't admit it."

Nelson said the object of his team will be to control the ball and keep

A&M's offense off the field, although that will be difficult with the speed of the Aggie defense.

"Our biggest advantage is that we've had a week off to work out the kinks and re-evaluate," Nelson said.

But if anything is good about losing to LSU, it's that the players

should be fired up to play better football Saturday and eliminate the mistakes which cost them the LSU game.

"Are they embarrassed?" Sherrill queried. "Yes."

"Are they upset? Yes." "Can they correct it? Yes."

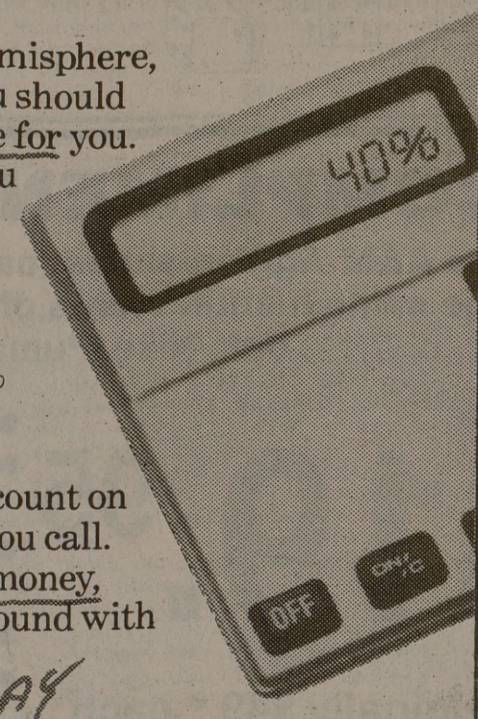
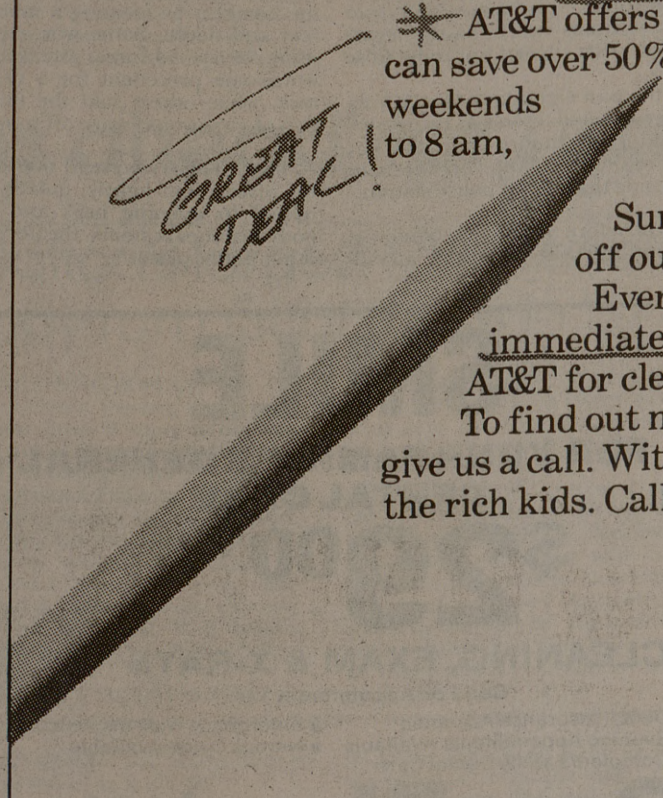
