UT opens questioning, probe into fraternity hazing death

AUSTIN (AP) — Questioning of more than 100 people began as University of Texas officials opened an investigation into the drinking death of a fraternity pledge.

Mark Seeberger, 18, was found dead of alcohol poisoning in his dormitory room Sept. 18.

News reports and court records said that Seeberger had been on a fraternity "ride" the night before his death, when he allegedly was handcuffed and told to drink.

Ronald Brown, UT vice president for student affairs, said students were being questioned "to determine if hazing in any way contributed to Mr. Seeberger's death, if hazing takes place regularly in this organization and to determine the fraternity's (alcohol) policy."

UT had deferred its investigation to avoid interfering with the police probe, Brown said.
