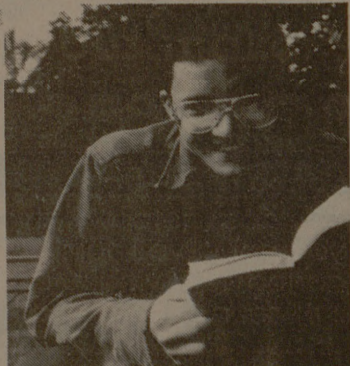

ranean for bomb and rocket runs starting at 3:50 p.m.

Police said the targets were four bases of the Palestine Liberation Army, the regular military arm of Yasser Arafat's Palestine Liberation Organization. The Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine led by George Habash said one of its bases was demolished.

Israel's command reported the raids hours later, but not the loss of a plane, and heavily censored dispatches by journalists. The Israeli military normally does not give detailed reports on raids until it has accounted for all men and aircraft.

A Shiite Moslem militia commander said the two pilots parachuted into an olive grove between Siroubieh and Anqoun, and one was captured.

"There are several cases where indeed we've lost faculty because they are concerned about the state and they jumped at a chance they might not have jumped at before," he said. "But I can't be specific and we can't measure precisely at this time because they leave for other reasons also."

Glen Dowling, director of the planning office, said faculty turnover statistics have been prepared since 1976, but the office first started collecting data on the reasons for faculty departures last year.

Dowling said preliminary data from this academic year indicates no significant changes in faculty departure trends from last year. He added that several factors have contributed to the stabiliza-

tion of a potentially volatile situation created by the budget cuts.

University officials organized a strong campaign to better inform the Legislature, he said. This resulted in budget cuts which were not as deep as once anticipated and aren't damaging vital programs or laying off personnel.

He said faculty loyalty also played an important part in stabilizing the situation.

"The clouds of doom were gathering early in the spring," Dowling said, "and rumors of drastic cuts appeared imminent."

"I believe the faculty has demonstrated great loyalty to the University and confidence that the administration and Board of Regents are committed to preserving the quality of our program through periods of economic recession."

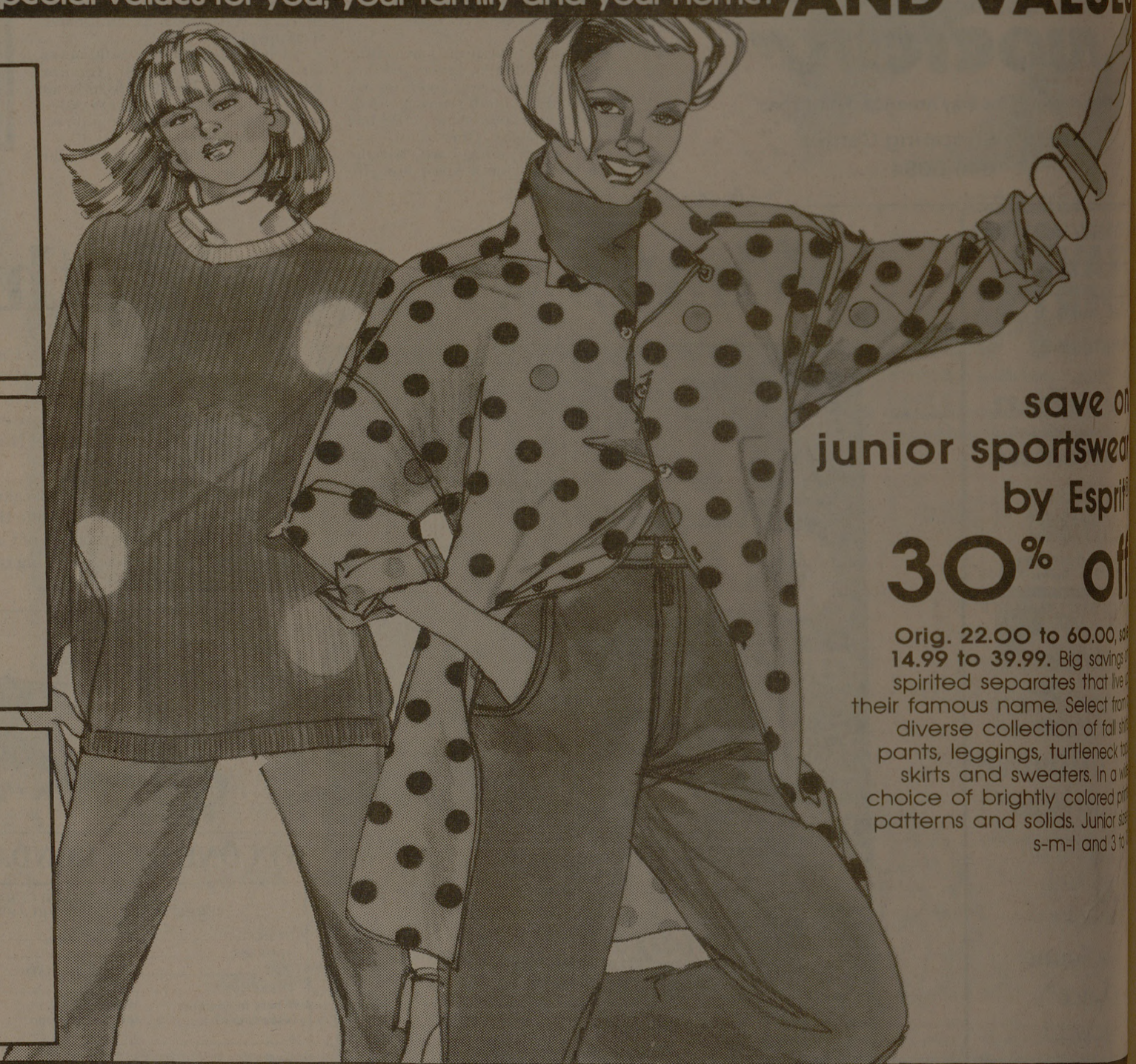
