LITTLE ROCK (AP) — A couple of days before the Houston game, Arkansas cornerback Charles Washington was passing by the office of defensive coordinator Fred Golds-

IRVING (AP) - Tex Schramm raised his fist in triumph when the Dallas Cowboys traded up to take wide receiver Mike Sherrard in the first round of the NFL draft.

"It's about time we finally did something right," Schramm said, who had been unhappy with the Cowboys' first-round mistakes the

previous five years.

The Cowboys haven't been sorry a second since they took the speedy Sherrard, a rookie from UCLA who

specializes in sensational catches.
"He gives something to our offense we've never had before," quarterback Danny White said. "He's so fast it's hard to lead him enough.
And he has great hands. He makes the routine catches and he makes the great catches. It's impossible to overthrow him, and believe me I've wind."

Sherrard missed the first five weeks of training camp in a contract dispute, but the Cowboys knew what he could do because of his extensive work at Valley Ranch in the off-sea-

las coach Tom Landry said. "He'll take some of the double coverage off

Sherrard still isn't being double-teamed by most clubs although he has caught touchdown passes of 22, 27, 36 and 39 yards.
