

Akeem Olajuwon led all scorers ith 31, including three late baskets hat pulled the Rockets within three, 95, with 1:18 left to play.

Houston led 80-75 going into the ourth quarter, but Lancaster Goron scored six of the Clippers first 2 points as the Clippers outscored ouston 12-2 in the first six minutes the fourth quarter.

Los Angeles took an early 8-3 lead, but Houston battled back to lead 29-27 going into the second quarter behind Olajuwon's 14 firstquarter points.

Olajuwon and Robert Reid each scored five points in the 1:33 of the second quarter as Houston took its biggest lead, 39-29.

The Clippers then held the Rockets to 14 points in the next 10:22 of play to take a 56-53 halftime advantage

The Clippers increased their lead 68-62 midway through the third quarter. The Rockets then scored 10 straight points to led 72-68 with 3:04 left in the third quarter.

Houston's Rodney McCray scored 12 third-quarter points, 10 of which came in the final 3:19 of the quarter.
