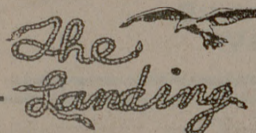

## Council to honor murdered student with fund, books

Although Linden Kauffman-Linam was only at Texas A&M for a short time, the efforts of some concerned students may ensure that she is remembered for many years to come.

The Oceanography Graduate Council has set up a memorial fund for Kauffman-Linam to help pay for a plaque and a series of books that will be added to the oceanography department's library.

On Nov. 25, Kauffman-Linam's body was found by a classmate who had become worried and stopped by Kauffman-Linam's apartment after she had missed a class. She apparently had been strangled in the bedroom of her apartment, County Sheriff Ronnie Miller said.

Malcolm Trent Primrose, 23, of College Station was indicted by the Brazos County grand jury in connection with the death of Kauffman-Linam. He is being held without bond in the Brazos County Jail.

Kauffman-Linam, 34, was a graduate student of the Department of Oceanography. This was her first semester at A&M and she had lived here only three months.

Peggy Myre, spokesman for the graduate council, said, "It was kind of a shocking thing within the department."

Eileen Hofmann, Kauffman-Linam's graduate adviser, said Kauffman-Linam was just beginning to make friends in her classes.

"She was just really starting to develop friendships," Hofmann said.

Hofmann added that Kauffman-Linam was a very serious student. It was when she missed giving a class presentation that classmates began to worry about her.

The department is fairly small,

and many students wanted something for her, Myre said.

Robert Reid, head of the oceanography department, said Hofmann wanted to name the series Kauffman-Linam as a memorial. "This was something we thought would be appropriate," Reid said. Myre said, "After getting the from her family, we felt there would be the best way to remember her."

The Kauffman-Linam series be comprised of books published by the American Association of Petroleum Geologists.

"The first books in the series will be concerned with geology because that was her area of interest," Myre said. "But eventually we want to add books on biochemistry and physics to the series."

A few books will be purchased, and a new book will be added to the series each year, Myre said.

The books will be kept in an area in The Working Collection Oceanography and Meteorology collection of literary works in the departments and located on the 11th floor of the O&M Building.

A bronze plaque with a memorial inscription will be placed near the collection, Reid said.

The collection houses books of a wide range of subjects, and encourages geology majors and students from all departments in the library and use the series as the library's other resources.

A special account has been set up for donations from faculty, students or anyone else who wishes to contribute, Reid said.

## Robbery suspect ailing after ingesting drugs

CLYDE (AP) — A man held up a drug store and led police officers on a chase before returning to the pharmacy where he held a man hostage for over two hours, police said Sunday.

Gary Don Parks, 35, of Fluvanna, was hospitalized in serious condition at Hendrick Medical Center at Abilene suffering the effects of drugs he took during the standoff, police said.

He was being held for investigation of armed robbery and kidnapping, investigators said.

Callahan County Chief Deputy Mack West said the man, armed with a plastic toy pistol, held up Howle's Discount Pharmacy in Clyde Saturday morning and fled with drugs.

After the robber was spotted driving into Abilene, officers pursued him back to Clyde, where he returned to the drug store and held the pharmacist's brother hostage.

The hostage escaped after the suspect put himself in a suspect's pocket, and I could see the Howle said.

Authorities said the man had the store's owner, Larry Howle, note demanding drugs, syringes and cash.

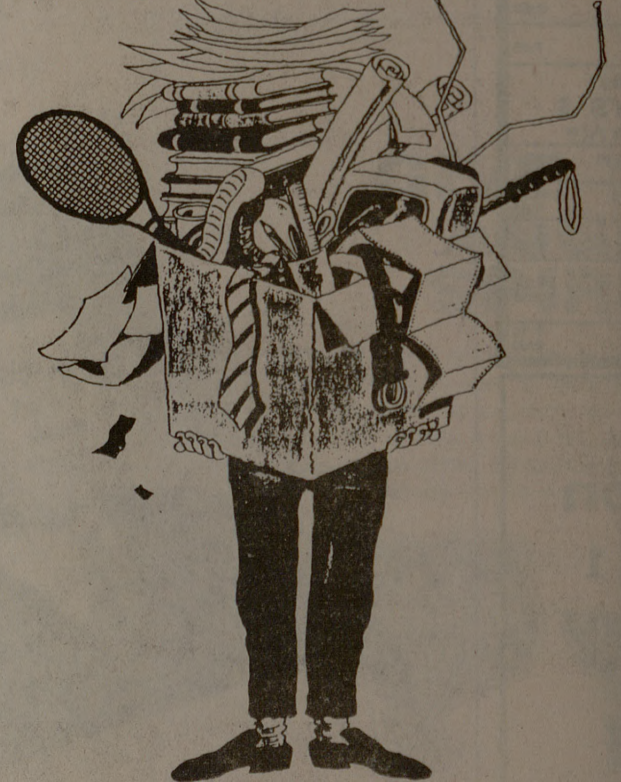
"At first I thought it was a robbery but then he said he had a pocket, and I could see the Howle said.
