# New 'emergency rules' issued in South Africa

## Police chief gets great censorship powers

JOHANNESBURG, South Africa (AP) — A judge nullified one of the police commissioner's press restrictions Thursday and the government responded hours later with new emergency rules allowing him to ban "any matter" he chooses.

An attorney who represents news media, Paul Jenkins, said Police Commissioner Johan Coetzee had been "elevated to the country's chief censor."

The commissioner used his new authority within two hours, issuing an order at 1 a.m. Friday prohibiting publication of advertisements "which defended, praised or endeavored to justify unlawful organizations' campaigns, projects, programs or actions."

Judge H. Daniel of Rand Supreme Court in Johannesburg invalidated an order Coetzee issued Jan. 8, the day after 22 newspapers published advertisements urging legalization of the African National Congress, the main guerrilla group fighting white rule.

Although Coetzee's order Friday morning referred only to advertisements, the one struck down by the judge also had prohibited news reports and comment that explained, defended, supported or might enhance the public image of any banned organization, such as the African National Congress.

Daniel said Coetzee had no authority to issue a nationwide ban.

Under the new rules: "The commissioner may, for the purpose of the safety of the public, the maintenance of public order or the termination of the state of emergency, and without prior notice to any person and without hearing any person, issue any order not inconsistent with a provision of these regulations prohibiting any publication, television recording, film recording or sound recording containing any news, comment, or advertisement on or in connection with any matter specified in the order, to be published."

They are encompassed by stricter press code President Pieter Botha promulgated Dec. 11 under the state of emergency imposed June 12, 1986.

Those rules severely restricted banned reporting on unrest, serious force actions, treatment of the press, most forms of peaceful protest and a broad range of statements. They are being challenged in Pietermaritzburg Supreme Court Natal province.

By custom in South Africa, laws by provincial supreme courts are followed throughout the country unless another supreme court decides differently. In that case, the law goes to the South Africa's highest court, the Court of Appeal.
