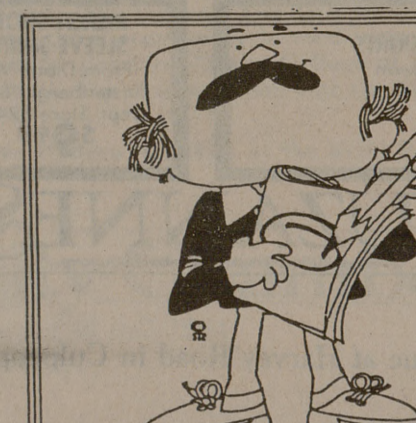

Educators say plans to cope with teen suicides are crucial

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — A plan to cope with adolescent suicides is crucial to other students and always should be in place in schools across the country, a principal told other educators Tuesday.

About 18 adolescents commit suicide each day, or 6,570 a year, said Richard Dempsey, a professor in the Department of Educational Leadership at the University of Connecticut.

He said many teen-age deaths are apt to be reported as accidents and added there could be as many as 25,000 adolescent suicides each year.

John Smith, principal of New Canaan, High School in Connecticut, said that in January 1985, one of his students hosted a party, then went upstairs and shot himself.

He said the shooting occurred over a weekend, so he had time to prepare the faculty to deal with the student's emotions.

"No matter how much time you have, the best thing to do is have your plan in place before something like this happens," Smith told the National Association of Secondary School Principals.

the deceased student's parents.

Smith said he became depressed while trying to cope with students and faculty members' problems at the suicide.

"I got absolutely numb," he said. "My brain worked, but I could feel anything emotionally."

Edward J. Shine, principal of Grosse Pointe South High School in Michigan, said one student committed suicide in October 1985.

10 others tried to kill themselves during two weeks in March 1986.

He said students may attempt suicide because of societal changes, cause stress.

"There is enormous pressure on young people to grow up before they're ready," he said. "Pressure, grades, pressure to perform, sure to be involved, performance long."

He said teachers can help. "We don't need to be over-protective," he said. "We need to be with the kids."
