

# Educators say plans to cope with teen suicides are crucio

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — A plan to cope with adolescent suicides is crucial to other students and always should be in place in schools across the country, a principal told other educators Tuesday.

About 18 adolescents commit suicide each day, or 6,570 a year, said Richard Dempsey, a professor in the Department of Educational Leadership at the University of Connecti-

He said many teen-age deaths are apt to be reported as accidents and

added there could be as many as 25,000 adolescent suicides each year.

John Smith, principal of New Canaan, High School in Connecticut, said that in January 1985, one of his students hosted a party, then went upstairs and shot himself.

He said the shooting occurred
