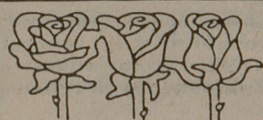

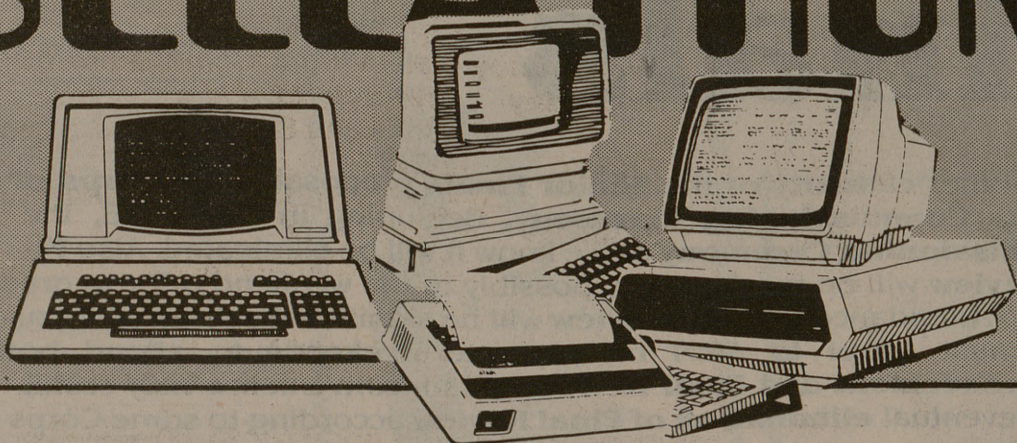

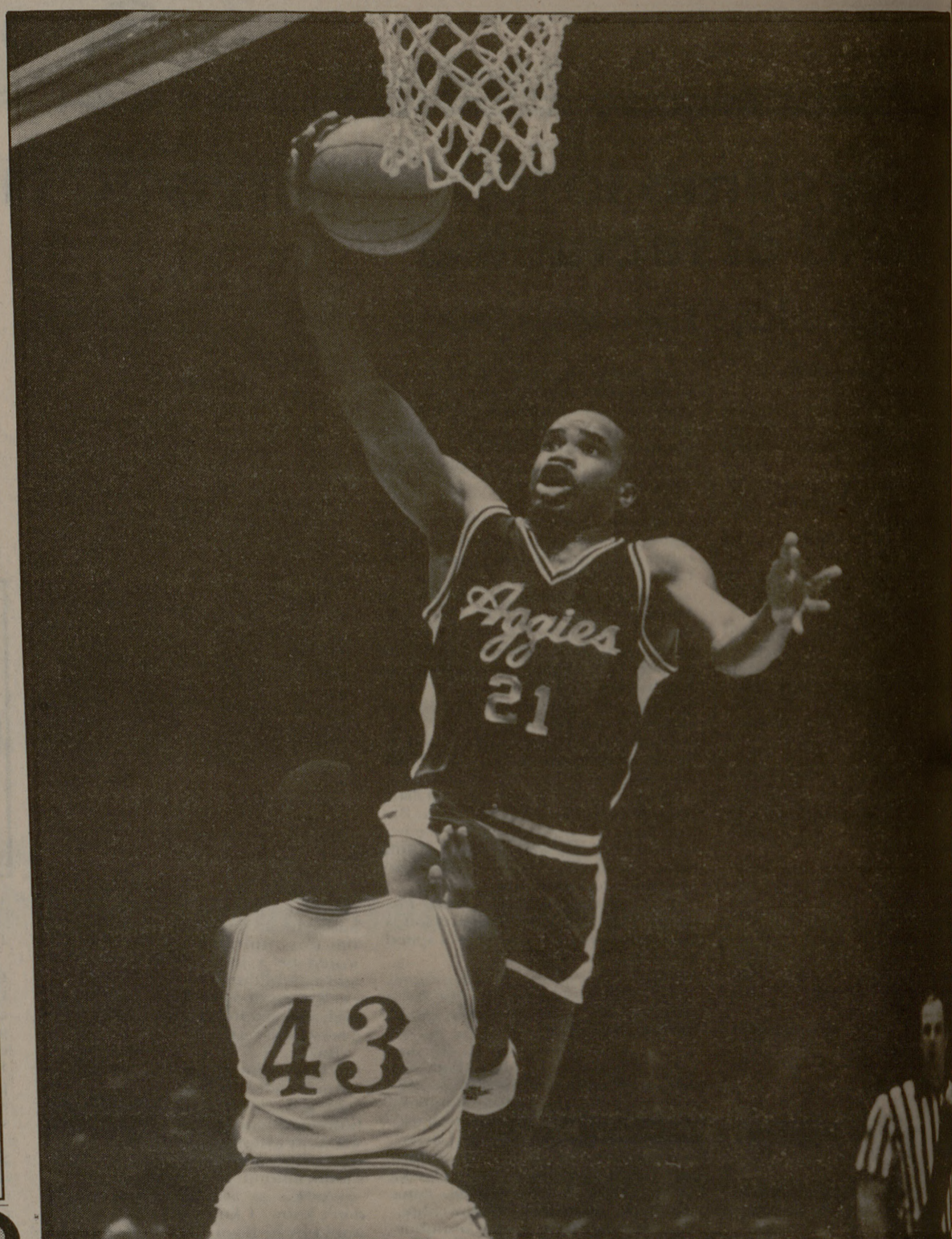

McDonald jumper lifts Ags over Horns 58-56

The Texas A&M men's basketball team, coming off a five game losing streak, got a 12-foot jump shot from Darryl McDonald with four seconds left to lift the Aggies to a 58-56 victory over Texas Wednesday night in front of 6,573 fans at the Frank Irwin Special Events Center.

"If the opponent is in a man defense, we like Darryl to go one-on-one," A&M Coach Shelby Metcalf said. "He is something special."

Forward John Trezvant opened the scoring for the Aggies at the 18:23 mark. And after a Keron Graves bucket, the Aggies were off to a 4-0 start.

But Texas, led by Alex Broadway

and Patrick Fairs battled back to give Texas an 8-6 lead with 13:53 left in the first half.

Winston Crite, who led all scorers in the first half with 13 points on 6 of 6 shooting, then hit a 3-point play at the 13:44 mark to give A&M a 9-8 lead it would never relinquish in the first half.

At one point, the Aggies were able to open an 11-point lead at 29-18, and the half ended at 35-27.

The Longhorns came out in the second half with a tough man-to-man defense and held the Aggies scoreless until the 14:21 mark, when Mike Clifford got a tip-in to make the score 37-31. Prior to that, both teams had made eight trips down the court without a basket.

At the 9:59 mark with the Aggies

on top 41-37, forward Thomas fouled Broadway who both free throws to bring the Longhorns within two.

Keron Graves, however, put the ball upcourt and hit a 3-point shot at the top of the key which called for traveling. Following Darryl McDonald steal and stuff, Longhorns used baskets by Farris and Raymond Davis to tie the score at 56-56 with 5:53 left.

After an Aggie miss, Patrick hit a 3-pointer and the Aggies chances of breaking their losing streak looked slim. However, Holloway hit the front end of a lay-up and-one, and when Crite got the low-up bucket on the missed shot.
