AUSTIN (AP) — A group of high school students, betting teen-agers want to dance more than they want to take drugs or drink, Wednesday announced the opening of a chemical-free hangout.

Lt. Gov. Bill Hobby called the project a "superb example of what concerned and involved citizens can do." The organization is relying on contributions from local citizens rather than tax money.

Carrier wins 21-year-old fight for intrastate delivery service

AUSTIN (AP) — A state appeals court Wednesday upheld a Railroad Commission order authorizing United Parcel Service to operate a small-package pickup and delivery service between all points in Texas.

The Legislature intended the Motor Carriers Act to be an exclusive statute only permitting such commercial carrier traffic as expressly authorized by its provisions. Wednesday's ruling was the latest action in a long battle over UPS shipments within Texas.

Court overturns argument against Speedy Trial Act

AUSTIN (AP) — The 3rd Court of Appeals Wednesday rejected the state's argument that the Speedy Trial Act is unconstitutional.
