Texas gets mone from Senate's 'no to Reagan veto

DALLAS (AP) — The Senate override of President Reagan's veto of the highway bill frees up \$850 million in federal funds for Texas highways in 1987, state officials said Thursday.

That money will support about 20,145 jobs in construction and related activities, said Marcy Goodfleisch, spokeswoman with the State Department of High-ways and Public Transportation in Austin.

It also may mean that Texans will be able to drive 65 mph on some highways by mid-summer, she said.
