Assistant Sports Editor The Texas A&M men's tennis team defeated Arkansas 7-2 Thursday at the Omar Smith Tennis Center. It was the Aggies first win over the Razorbacks in nine years.

A&M clinched the win after Dean Goldfine came from behind to win his No. 2 singles match. Goldfine and Arkansas' Danny Granot split the first two sets before Granot took a seemingly comfortable 5-1 lead in the third

and final set. But Goldfine was able to force a tie-breaker and win the match 6-0, 6-7, 7-6.

"I didn't want to give up, and he (Granot) was chipping and charging on the serve and vol-leying," Goldfine said. "We leying,' hadn't beaten Arkansas in a long time and that really made me want this one more. This was the best comeback that I can remember.

In all, A&M won five of the six singles matches. The Aggies' No. 1 singles player, Marcel Vos, beat

Simon Robinson in straight sets 6-3, 6-3. Vos is now 16-5 on the year in singles play.


Sports Writer The Texas A&M women's tennis team came through with a big conference win over Rice Thursday at
