Boy accused of shooting parents put on probation

HOUSTON (AP) — A 10-year-old boy accused of a Mother's Day shooting that killed his father and wounded his mother was sentenced to a year's probation Thursday, a prosecutor said.

The boy, who has been placed in the custody of a brother, also will undergo counseling, Assistant District Attorney Elizabeth Godwin said.

Godwin said the boy admitted to voluntary manslaughter in his father's death and aggravated assault in the shooting of his mother. He had faced a murder charge, she said.

After reviewing the evidence in the case, Godwin said, "We felt like reducing the charge was appropriate."

On Mother's Day, the boy hid the family's loaded .38-caliber gun from its hiding place in cushions of a living room and started firing after being told he could not play outside, police said.

The boy's father, Edward Sr., 45, was pronounced dead at the scene with a bullet wound to the head. After the gun was found, the boy's mother, Mary Smith, staggered outside and cried for help.

The boy fled the scene but was picked up by police about 30 minutes later and gave a videotaped interview to police.

Godwin said the boy has been in therapy.
