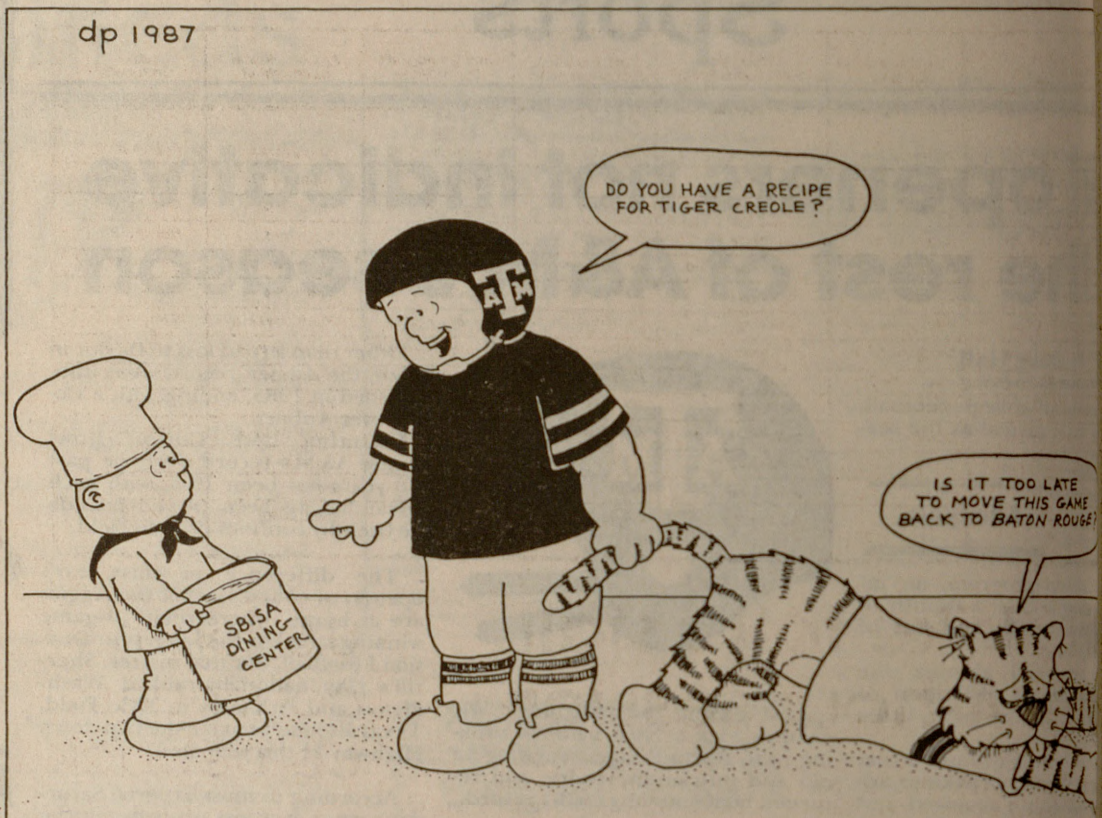

Houston reps say they've done all they can to keep Oilers home

HOUSTON (AP) — Houston officials say they have done all they can to keep the Oilers from moving to Jacksonville, Fla., when the NFL team's lease at the Astrodome expires at the end of this season.

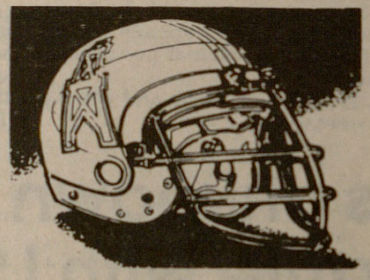
The Oilers are being wooed by Jacksonville officials to make the Gator Bowl their home.

Jacksonville Mayor Tommy Hazouri said he thinks the north Florida city can deliver on its proposal of guaranteeing \$115.2 million over the next 10 years for the National League team.

Oiler owner K.S. "Bud" Adams confirmed Tuesday that he is asking for that sum.

Harris County Judge Jon Lindsay reiterated Wednesday that the county has scheduled a vote by the public on \$50 million in bonds to pay for 10,000 new seats, a new playing surface and other Astrodome improvements.

By law, Lindsay noted, tax money cannot be used to sweeten the pot by



directly underwriting Oiler profits, even if thought desirable.

Several officials said that until Jacksonville puts its chips on the table, any move by the Houston private sector to raise such funds would be premature.

Lindsay said the issue remains in the hands of the Oilers and the Houston Sports Association, which owns the Astros baseball team.

HSA leases the Astrodome from Harris County for \$750,000 and charges the Oilers \$2 million a year to play in it.

The Oilers want HSA to ante up \$1 million and give them of parking and concessions. In Jacksonville, the Oilers supposedly receive such a sum and pay only \$250,000 a year.

KTRK-TV reported Wednesday that the Oilers had told Adams they would come up with a better offer by 5 p.m. Thursday or Friday.

Adams said Wednesday he had no comment and that Manager Ladd Herzog was handling the negotiations.

Efforts by Jacksonville to ante up the \$115.2 million, however, could collapse if the Florida legislature does not approve a 50 percent increase in Jacksonville's hotel tax, the Florida-Times Herald reported Thursday.
