## Meese says drug seized, 29 caught in big drug cartel

WASHINGTON (AP) — Twenty-nine people have been arrested and more than 70 tons of marijuana and nearly one ton of cocaine seized in five cities in the breakup of a major international drug cartel, Attorney General Edwin Meese III said Wednesday.

Meese said the year-long investigation, code-named "Operation Intruder," involved the use of Drug Enforcement Administration agents as middlemen for distributing marijuana and cocaine to Atlanta, Denver, Detroit, New York City and West Palm Beach, Fla.

The operation culminated Tuesday with the last of the arrests. The drug seizures and the confiscation of \$2 million in cash and \$650,000 in property also ended, he said.

Among those arrested, Meese said, were three Colombians whom he described as "major movers in the cartel."

He said two of the three flew to Miami after they were told they would be paid for their efforts there. "A third lives in Miami."

"This is one of the more significant drug cases we have had," Meese told a news conference.

He said later, however, "We don't know the exact effect this will have on the street."

He said the \$2 million cost of the operation was paid for with the drug traffickers' money.

Meese said the operation represented half of a two-pronged Reagan administration strategy to battle the drug use in the United States — through the use of law enforcement and through limiting demands.

On the second front, Meese said recent surveys by the National Institute of Drug Abuse found that drug use among high school students has leveled off somewhat and that "a higher percentage now regard it as unhealthful and improper behavior."

But in a statement released after the news conference, Rep. Charles Rangel, D-N.Y., chairman of the House Select Committee on Narcotics, said:

"One bust does not a national policy make," he said. "We expect unprecedented amounts of cocaine, marijuana and heroin to come into the country."

"Production is up in all drug-producing countries."

DEA Administrator John C. Lawn, appearing at the Justice Department news conference, said the Colombia-based drug-trafficking or-

ganization has been operating at least 10 years.

Lawn said the drug traffic Colombia and the United States ferred DEA undercover agents more than \$2 million to take the marijuana all the way from Colombia to the United States, unloading warehouses rented in Texas, distribute the drugs by truck to Denver, Detroit and West Palm Beach.

Lawn said the ship used to transport the marijuana was seized earlier this year.

It sailed to the northern Colombia in late July and was with 128,500 pounds of marijuana. The ship then sailed to the western U.S. where it was met by a first DEA agents, who then shipped to Port Isabel.

There, agents unloaded the marijuana on Aug. 5 and stored ready-rented warehouse, said.

During the next few weeks, said, about 50,000 pounds of marijuana by truck to Atlanta, another 50,000 pounds to Denver and 50,000 pounds to West Palm Beach.

In a second part of the operation, traffickers based in Detroit, Michigan, flew to Miami to meet the plane from Miami to Detroit and then to Detroit on Sept. 10. A load of 18,000 pounds of marijuana and 1,300 pounds of cocaine were loaded the drugs, stored in a Detroit-area warehouse at the same time they were taken to the cocaine to New York City. He said the nine had taken the cocaine to New York City. All of the marijuana from the other cities also was taken to New York City. They were another 13,000 pounds of marijuana in a Port Isabel house, Lawn said.

In Harlingen, they seized cocaine and orange grove. He identified the three "major movers," who rested in Miami, as Gustavo Vega of Cartagena, Joaquin Vega of Santa Marta and Rafael Calvo, a Colombian with a driver's license.

Lawn said that among those arrested were Justin "Doc" Denver, identified as the broker for the Denver and negotiations; and Alejandro Vega of Boca Raton, Fla., identified as the trafficking negotiator in Detroit and West Palm Beach.

The scandal-plagued Bronx, N.Y., defense contractor's top officers, including founder John Mariotta, also "looted" the corporate treasury and set up a slush fund to exploit a Small Business Administration program aimed at helping minority contractors, Martin Pollner told the Senate Governmental Affairs subcommittee on oversight of government management.


Relying on records supplied by Pollner, the panel said Nozfiger, his lobbying partner Mark Bragg and five Wedtech executives sold 1 million shares of Wedtech stock for \$10 million on March 26-27 and April 9-10, 1986, before it was announced SBA had finally cut the contractor out of the so-called 8a program.

The revocation by SBA, because the company was no longer a minority-owned business, sent the stock prices plummeting. The 8a minority set-aside program provided almost all of Wedtech's business. Under it, the company had been awarded some \$250 million in government work without a competitive bidding.

Information about the scandal being referred to the Securities Exchange Commission for investigation, subcommittee chairman Carl Levin, D-Mich, said.

Nozfiger and Bragg, who were under indictment for alleged lobbying of the White House, half of Wedtech, each sold Wedtech stock in March for \$326,000, Pollner's records show.

Levin said, "While millions of dollars were bled from companies to line the pockets of company officers and well-placed congressional American taxpayers lost tens of millions of dollars paid for products that Wedtech would never deliver."
