

Tar Heels face tall task against No. 1 Sooners

Back in 1980, North Carolina had just beaten North Carolina State 28-8 to go 6-0 and was about to move up from No. 8 to No. 7 in the Associated Press rankings.

As they were leaving the stadium, a member of North Carolina's athletic department turned to a writer friend and said, "Boy, do we get a break. In two weeks we go out to play Oklahoma, but next week we play East Carolina and they run the wishbone just like Oklahoma."

The Tar Heels disposed of East Carolina 31-3 and moved up to No. 6. The following weekend, they moved (1) to Norman, Okla., and (2) out of the Top Ten.

The final score was 41-7, Carolina's only loss in an 11-1 season, as

Oklahoma rushed for 495 yards — quarterback J.C. Watts had 139 — and scored six times on the ground.

Oklahoma is a 23-point favorite but bear in mind that North Carolina has a classic dropback passer in Mark Maye. Also bear in mind that outstanding passers have given Oklahoma fits in the past.

The pick is Oklahoma 28-21.
No. 3 UCLA at No. 2 Nebraska (favored by 6½): One of them won't be in the top three next week. Nebraska 20-17.

No. 16 Notre Dame at No. 9 Michigan (by 4): Notre Dame begins its 100th year of football. Michigan 20-13.

No. 19 Alabama at No. 3 Penn State (by 3): Penn State 24-17.

Kansas at No. 4 Auburn (by 35½): Auburn 38-10.

West Virginia at No. 5 Ohio State (by 17): Ohio State 35-7.

Fullerton State at No. 6 LSU (no line): You just know Fullerton State was looking ahead last week when it lost to Hawaii 44-0. LSU 45-0.

No. 8 Florida State (by 18½) at East Carolina: The Seminoles have some tough games down the road. This week's road is a primrose path. Florida State 38-14.

No. 10 Clemson (by 13½) at Virginia Tech: Tech's new battle cry is "Leave it to Beamer" — as in new Coach Frank Beamer. Clemson 27-10.

Purdue at No. 12 Washington (by 22): Washington 28-7.

No. 13 Arkansas (by 4) at Missis-

issippi: Could Ole Miss possibly have been looking ahead when it was upset by Memphis State last week? The Southwest Conference's miseries continue. Mississippi 21-20.

No. 14 Tennessee (by 9) at Mississippi State: Upset Special of the Week: Mississippi State 24-20.

No. 15 Arizona State (by 7) at Illinois: Last year, ASU won the Pac-10 title. This time, Coach John Cooper says the Sun Devils are shooting for bigger game. Arizona State 27-13.

North Carolina State at No. 18 Pitt (by 17½): Pitt 35-14.

Oregon State at No. 20 Georgia (by 18½): Georgia 37-14.

Baylor (by 6½) at Missouri: The Bears were rebuilding even before quarterback Ed Lovell got hurt. Second Upset Special: Missouri 24-17.

Driver in critical condition after crash at Indianapolis

INDIANAPOLIS (AP)—Indy-car driver Roberto Guerrero is in critical condition Thursday after his car hit the second-turn wall at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway during tire tests.

Guerrero, 29, was taken to Methodist Hospital with moderate to severe head injuries, CART medical director Dr. Stephen Olvey said.

The Colombian native won the Escort Radar Warning 200 Sunday at the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course in Lexington, Ohio.

Car owner Vince Granatelli speculated that the car's right

front wheel may have come off and struck Guerrero in the head. The driver was unconscious when he was removed from the car and taken to the hospital by ambulance.

In his fourth year on the CART standings, Guerrero has 37 points behind leading champion Bobby Rahal and six behind runnerup Michele Alboreto.

Guerrero won the first race of his career this season at the weekend at Lexington, Ohio.
