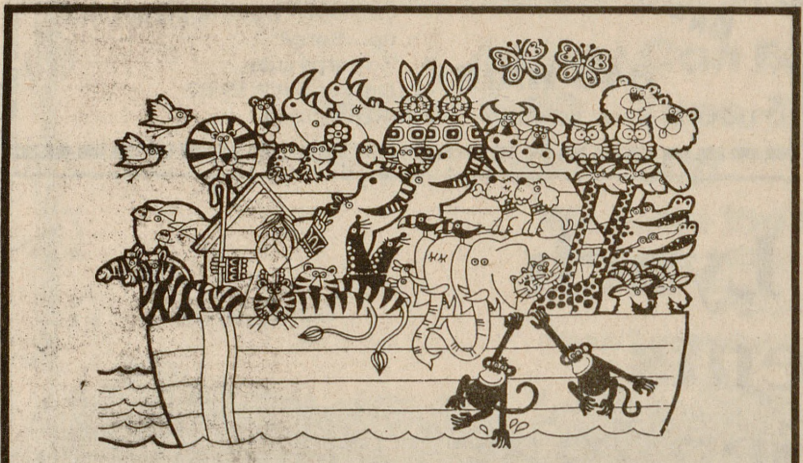

Sources: Secord has closed office in search of work

WASHINGTON (AP) — Richard V. Secord has closed his office, effectively ended his business with Iran-Contramaoneyman Albert Hakim and is looking for work, according to sources familiar with his situation. Secord, 55, a retired Air Force major general who played a principal part in the Iran-Contra case, is one of the targets of the independent counsel investigation. Although he has given a few speeches, Secord is "not a hot property" on the lecture circuit, said one source, speaking on condition he remain anonymous. The source later added, "He doesn't have a lot of money." Secord didn't get paid for the long interview in the October edition of Playboy magazine, according to journalist Morgan Strong, who conducted the interview. Secord and Hakim, his former business partner at Stanford Technology Trading Group International, handled logistical and operational details of the program to sell U.S.-made weapons to Iran and divert the profits to the Nicaraguan Contras. They reported to Lt. Col. Oliver L. North, the National Security Council aide who was fired by President Reagan last November. Secord gave general instructions to Hakim, the financial wizard who controlled the money. Before they became linked to North in 1985, Secord and Hakim served as arms merchants for the Contras, buying and selling weapons at a profit. Business is booming at sex addiction clinic

NEW ORLEANS (AP) — The fear of AIDS is driving numbers of bisexual men to a New Orleans clinic for sex addicts as they face growing pressure to change their lifestyles, the clinic director says. Dr. Mark Schwartz, a psychiatrist who previously had worked on the staff of Masters & Johnson Institute, said he has treated more than 100 bisexual men with sexual addictions in the past year at his suburban clinic. "I've got probably over 25 bisexuals in treatment right now," he said. AIDS has "affected our clinic in a major way," Schwartz said. "People who used to pursue a sexual relationship outside the marital relationship are now feeling they need to get things under control." "Now suddenly an extramarital affair becomes a potentially lethal weapon." Schwartz's 12-bed Sexual Addictions Clinic is drawing a waiting list from across the nation from addicts who he said typically use sex to escape the distresses of daily living. But it's not just bisexual men with sex addictions seeking his help. From laborers to company executives, more and more Americans are seeking treatment of sexual addictions, including a growing population that is also hooked on drugs and alcohol, Schwartz said. "There is a phenomenon here, and we're not talking about a few people," Schwartz said. That unknown number of American sex addicts is dabbling in a range of activities from the legal to the illicit, including promiscuity, pornography, voyeurism, prostitution and exhibitionism, he said. Sex becomes the quick fix that fills a "hole in the middle of his gut," Schwartz said. "Just as the gambler is drawn to the fast-paced dice game and the cocaine user seeks the exhilarating rush from the drug, the sexual addict... turns to sex as a magical solution to a variety of life's problems and stresses," he said. Many of Schwartz's patients are or have been addicted to drugs or alcohol, many were sexually abused or

Wizard of Oz producer dies at 86

BEVERLY HILLS (AP) — Oscar-winning Mervyn LeRoy produced "The Wizard of Oz" and directed scores of films including "Mister Roberts," "The heart failure Sunday, his agent said. He was 86. LeRoy died in his sleep Beverly Hills home, said business manager, Given Eaton. LeRoy had Alzheimer's disease and had been ill Christmas with respiratory ailments, Eaton added. "I would say he was one of Hollywood's greats," said Eaton. LeRoy won a best director award in 1942 for the film "The Harvest," an honorary Oscar in 1945 for the short subject "The House I Live In," and the Frank Sinatra, and the Thalberg Memorial Award in 1975. It was LeRoy who introduced Ronald Reagan to Nancy. He was also the man who introduced Lana Turner to the attention of the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer studios in 1938. From the White House president and Mrs. Reagan's a statement Sunday, saying always referred to him as "papa."
