Richards spent several weeks testing the political waters before telling Associated Press on Sunday night that she will run for governor. She said that only unanticipated developments could keep her out of

Richards became the first major-party candidate to declare a definite intention to run. Mattox said he probably will announce after the 1988 presidential election.

"I doubt very seriously if she's going to be a candidate, when all is said and done," Mattox said. "It's "Some politicians get into races without having the support of the people, and I don't intend to do that," Mattox said.
