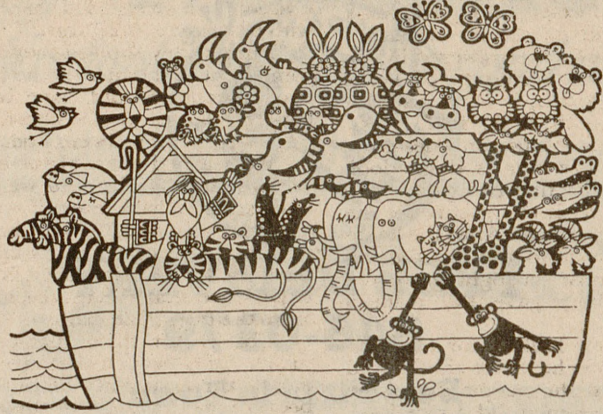

## Kremlin issues invitation for talk on human rights

VIENNA, Austria (AP) — The Kremlin issued an invitation to a Western group highly critical of its human rights policy to meet officials in Moscow, the Soviet envoy to the 35-nation Helsinki review conference announced Tuesday.

Western officials welcomed the unprecedented invitation and other recent shifts in Moscow's human rights policy, but insisted on more improvements before signing an accord to end the conference.

"In the all important areas of human rights and human contacts, there is still a shortfall... of deeds to match the ambitious language of perestroika," David Mellor, Minister of State in Britain's Foreign Office, said as the fourth round of talks opened.

The 35 nations signed a human rights agreement in 1975 in the Finnish capital of Helsinki. The conference was supposed to end last

July. Diplomats now say they hope to reach agreement by Christmas.

Soviet Ambassador Yuri D. Kashlev told a news conference that Moscow has invited a delegation from the International Helsinki Federation, a private group that monitors human rights, to discuss policy with high-level Kremlin officials.

Gerard Nagler, senior representative of the International Helsinki Federation in Vienna, said a 12-member delegation from various West European countries would go to Moscow in November for five days of meetings.

Nagler said his organization, founded in 1982 by U.S. and West European groups that monitor compliance with the 1975 Helsinki human rights accords, applied for the visit in June. He received word last Friday it could go ahead.

Word of the meeting follows talks in Washington last week at which the Soviets announced plans to repeal laws against defaming the Soviet sys-

tem and religious activity, and to release prisoners jailed under laws.

Kashlev said nearly 20,000 have been allowed to travel abroad this year. Most of this news was welcome, but the number did not match figures of the late 1970s, when up to 50,000 left the Soviet Union each year. He did not comply fully with the Helsinki Final Act.

In separate speeches, Canadian Ambassador Bauer stressed that it should be a person who can travel abroad, as it is in the Soviet Union, much of the Soviet bloc.

Kashlev gave no indication the Kremlin will meet Western demands for a permanent mechanism to monitor human rights or guarantees that anyone can travel abroad if it is held in confidence and will be able to speak freely.

## Hahn says sexual encounter with Bakker 'ruined her life'

CHARLOTTE, N.C. (AP) — Jessica Hahn, declaring "I am not a bimbo," says in a Playboy magazine interview that she "hated every second" of her sexual encounter with PTL founder Jim Bakker seven years ago and "it has ruined my life."

A copy of the November issue of the magazine, which includes a 31-page interview and semi-nude photo layout of Hahn, became available Tuesday as she concluded two days of testimony before a federal grand jury looking into hush money paid to her after the liaison.

"You know, two men had me in one day," Hahn said in the interview, referring to Bakker and Okla-

homa City evangelist John Fletcher, who she said accompanied him to a Florida motel room for the tryst with the young church secretary.

Bakker, who resigned in disgrace from the TV ministry after Hahn's story became public, has acknowledged having sex with her but claims she was the one who seduced him.

Fletcher has acknowledged introducing Bakker to Hahn, but has not commented on her allegations that he also had sex with her.

Hahn's lawyer, Dominic Barbara, said her two days of testimony before the grand jury focused on possible IRS violation by the PTL in connection with the hush money. Hahn

is testifying under a limited immunity from prosecution.

In the Playboy interview, Hahn said: "This is supposed to be the bimbo, right? So let's see the fact that I am not a bimbo, human being."

Bakker resigned from the PTL in March after the PTL Offense Playoffs. Hahn, at that time a church secretary in New York, became a PTL star. Hahn said she had agreed to accept \$265,000 for her second half, including the PTL's share of the PTL's profits. She broke silence when she testified that Barbara said Hahn had received \$20,300 before payments stopped.

## Attorney accuses U.S. of injuring hijacker

WASHINGTON (AP) — Fawaz Younis, the hijacking suspect arrested after being lured by the FBI onto a yacht in the Mediterranean, appeared in court Tuesday with broken wrists and in casts nearly up to his elbows as his attorney accused the government of being responsible for the injuries.

Younis' attorney, Frank Carter, said his client suffered the broken wrists following his arrest and that his client had been "interrogated three times a day" during a "trip around the Mediterranean for five days" while the 28-year-old Lebanese Shiite was aboard a navy vessel.

Younis, charged with being the ringleader in the June 1985 hijacking of a Jordanian airliner, was lured

aboard an FBI-rented yacht Sept. 13 with the promise of a drug deal and then clasped in handcuffs.

"Based on what we know, it appears that it was accidental," one department official who spoke on condition of anonymity said.

At the bond hearing, the government showed on courtroom television monitors a videotape of the hijackers in 1985 showing one of the hijackers, who looked like Younis, announcing to reporters that the hijacked plane was about to be blown up with Jordanian sky marshals still aboard.

FBI Agent John Lipka testified at the bond hearing that "in my opinion" the hijacker on the videotape and Younis are "one and the same."

## Dan Rowan dies of cancer

ENGLEWOOD, Fla. (AP) — Dan Rowan, who teamed with Dick Martin for an irreverent 1960s comedy show, "Laugh-In," died Tuesday of cancer. He was 65.

Rowan died at 7:54 a.m. at his home on Manasota Key, Fla. His wife, Joanna, and daughter, Mary, at his bedside, said he had been a family spokesman for Douglas, a family spokesman.

The comedian, also known as "The Son of Sam," had been ill nine months ago of his illness.

"Tonight Show" host Jay Carson said, "I am stunned and saddened by the death of Dan Rowan."
