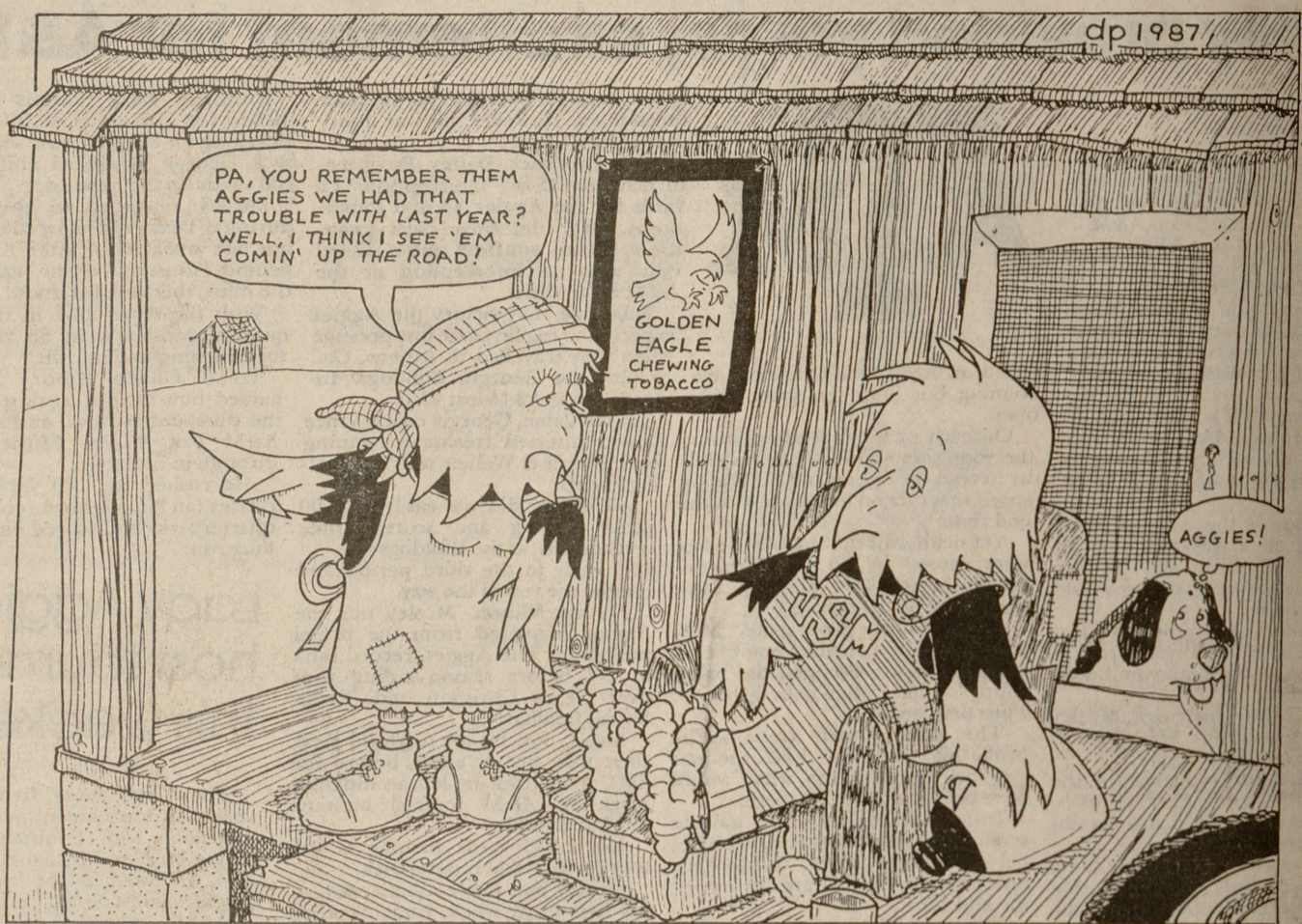

Strange, Kite to open Ryder Cup play for U.S.

DUBLIN, Ohio (AP) — The United States will send Curtis Strange and Tom Kite against Sam Torrance and Howard Clark Friday in the opening match of the 1987 Ryder Cup competition.
 American captain Jack Nicklaus left U.S. Open champion Scott Simpson and Ben Crenshaw on the sidelines for the four foursome matches that open the biennial competition between the United States and Europe.
 European captain Tony Jacklin also left one of his aces, Sandy Lyle, on the bench for the opening matches.
 Pairings for the other opening matches, in which each two-man

team plays alternate shots on the same ball, are: Hal Sutton and Dan Pohl vs. Ken Brown of Scotland and Bernhard Langer of West Germany; Lanny Wadkins and Masters champion Larry Mize vs. British Open champion Nick Faldo of England and Ian Woosnam of Wales; and PGA titleholder Larry Nelson and Payne Stewart vs. the Spanish team of Seve Ballesteros and Jose-Maria Olazabal.
 Pairings for the four afternoon fourball matches, in which scoring is based on the better ball of each two-man team, will be announced after the morning matches.
 Saturday's play will follow the

same format, four foursomes in the morning and four fourballs in the afternoon. Twelve singles matches will be played Sunday.
 Each match is worth one point. If a match is even after 18 holes, each team receives one-half point. A total of 14½ points is needed to win.
 The United States holds a 21-4-1 lead in the series that began in 1927 when Samuel Ryder, a British seed merchant, put up a cup for biennial competition between representatives of the United States and Britain.
 The British team was expanded to include all of Europe in 1979, providing that team with such players as

Ballesteros and Langer. In the last matches, at the Belfry in England in 1985, the Americans suffered their first defeat in 28 years.
 It stung.
 "It's like the America's Cup. People didn't pay a lot of attention to it until we lost it," Nicklaus said.
 "Our guys don't want it to happen again," he said.
 But, said Jacklin, "I think there is a possibility the Americans could lose" for the first time in the United States.
 "We really can win," Jacklin said.
 "I have no doubt my feelings are shared by the rest of the European side."
