calf isn't worried that that will hurt the Aggies.
 "We'll be one of the smaller teams in the league," Metcalf said. "It doesn't worry me. It just means we're going to have to make up for altitude with attitude. We'll have to get some great effort out of the small guys."
 "There'll be some guys who'll be playing above our heads. But we've got some competitors and that's where it all starts."
 "Rebounding could be a problem for us. We're going to have to play bigger inside than we are. But on the other hand, our strength is the guard position. Starting guards and depth-wise,

we're in good shape."
 Metcalf believes the SWC will continue to be a tough basketball conference.
 "This league is tough," he said. "Arkansas has Top 10 talent. And Houston may have Top 10 talent."
 "But by the time we get into conference, I think everything could fall into place and we could be competitive," Metcalf said.
 "It's important we stay healthy, happy and eligible. We just don't have a lot of depth. But right now we're undefeated."
 "Just come check us out," McDonald said to Aggie fans. "I think we're going to be good."

nese away from him. Also it takes other players time to get used to playing with him. Often his bad passes are passes to where they should be.
 "You take a player out of New York City — he'll play more basketball in a summer than some of these guys will play in their lives. It takes a while for these guys to know enough to play without the ball and be where they're supposed to be."
 McDonald recognizes and appreciates the freedom Metcalf gives him on the court.
 "They let me do my own thing," he said. "That's my style of playing.

If I start really getting out of hand with it, he (Metcalf) won't tell everybody, but he'll tell me, 'Let's keep it in the system.'"
 This summer when he wasn't working on his jump shot, or "J", "D-Mack The Playground King", as he's called in New York, was playing with other collegiate and pro players in summer tournaments. He played up to three games almost every day.
 "To me, the competition's rough," McDonald said. "Maybe it's because it's New York. I don't know."
 "Up there when I'm playing in the summer, it's basically unorganized. It's not like school. In the summer

you're just out there doing your thing. There ain't really no defense being played or none of that. I just go with the flow and do what I got to do."
 Since he is the Aggies' only returning starter this season, McDonald is being propelled into a leadership position, just as he was his sophomore year at Westchester.
 "It feels good to me," McDonald said about being a leader. "Now that Winston, Mike (Clifford) and Todd (Holloway) are gone and since I started for the NCAA team, I kind of felt like a lot of people would be looking up to me as a leader."
 In A&M's first round NCAA Tournament loss against Duke, Mc-

Donald didn't have a typical McDonald game. It is one that he would like to have back because the national audience that watched it didn't see true McDonald. One of the reasons may have been that the game played with a new ball, he said.
 "There was just something about that game," he said. "I wasn't scared or nothing. I didn't have the ball. They took the ball right out of my box. I tried to adjust to get the ball go my way, but the ball was slippery. I know I didn't play a game like I played in the SWC tournament. I would have loved to bring that game or take one of the games from the tournament and put it in that Duke game."
