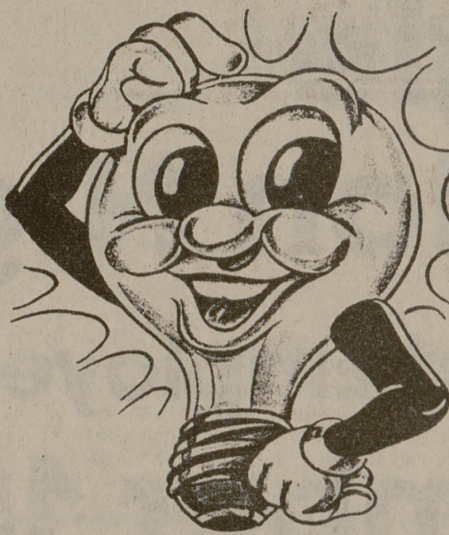
To RECEIVE YOUR SECURITY DEPOSIT BACK, you should also:

Club holds benefit concert to raise funds for transplant

Brazos Landing, a restaurant and club on Northgate, will have a benefit concert at 9:30 p.m. Saturday to help raise money for a liver transplant for John Stone, Class of '84.

The performers donating their time and talent are Tim Rogers, Pat Foster, Dave Fomogyi and the Starvin Marvin Band.

Rogers, Foster and Fomogyi will take turns playing 30- to 45-minute sessions until about 11:30 p.m.,

when Starvin Marvin will take over and play until about 1 a.m.

Rogers, who arranged the musical talent for the benefit, is a solo guitarist and vocalist and will play a variety of popular and rock songs.

Fomogyi and Foster also are solo guitarists and vocalists.

Fomogyi plays some classical songs as well as music by the bands Yes and Jethro Tull.

The Starvin Marvin band includes guitarist and lead vocalist Jeff Stephens, guitarist Tom

Spence, drummer Larry Cummins and bassist Ed Kuney.

The band plays new and old 'n' roll, blues and some original material.

Admission to the benefit is free and all of the earnings from the door will go to Stone to help him cover the costs of the operation.

Hugh Stearns, manager of Brazos Landing, said the restaurant also will donate 10 percent of Saturday's net proceeds to the transplant fund for Stone.

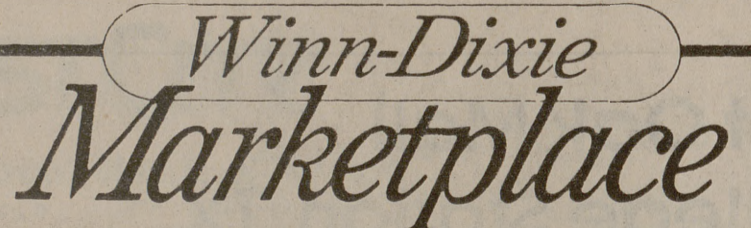
