

Mecham faces vote recall or resignation

PHOENIX, Ariz. (AP) — Gov. Evan Mecham will have to face a recall election or resign after the secretary of state announced Monday that his opponents had collected more than enough signatures to force such a vote.

Mecham, who also faces legislative impeachment hearings and criminal charges in connection with a campaign loan, repeated his assertion that he will not resign, a spokesman said

Rose Mofford, the Democratic secretary of state who would replace the Republican governor if he re-signs or is removed from office, said 301,032 signatures were verified. The Mecham Recall Committee needed 216,746 valid signatures to force a vote.

Meanwhile, an Arizona House select committee planned to continue hearings Monday on whether Mecham should be impeached. The governor also faces a March 9 criminal trial on six felony counts connected with his alleged concealment of the \$350,000 campaign loan he received from a developer.

Mofford said that she plans to no-tify Mecham on Tuesday that he has five days to resign, according to state law. If he does not, she is expected to schedule a recall vote by next Monday, probably for May 17, when a number of local elections are planned.

Recall Committee founder Ed Buck said he would be "pleasantly surprised" if Mecham resigned, but gubernatorial spokesman Ken Smith said the governor will not.

"Never, not during this term," said Smith, who added the governor believes he would win a recall vote.

When the recall petition cam-paign kicked off last July, Mecham questioned whether "a few homosex uals and dissident Democrats" could raise enough signatures. State GOP Chairman Burton

Kruglick said party leaders have not decided whether they would back Mecham in a recall vote. Mecham has been divisive to the party, the chairman said, adding, "This is out of our hands and we have to concentrate on the 1988 elections.

The House select committee was expected Monday to consider an allegation that the governor's car dealership improperly borrowed \$80,000 in what special counsel Wil-liam French said was state funds from the governor's protocol fund.

Gunmen kidnap, kill chief prosecutor

BOGOTA, Colombia (AP) -Gunmen kidnapped the country's chief prosecutor on Monday and killed him, a Colombian radio chain said.

The government had blamed the abduction on the Medellin Cartel, which U.S. officials say controls 80 percent of the cocaine entering the United States.

An unidentified person called the broadcast chain Caracol and said Attorney General Carlos Hoyos was executed for "betraying the country," Caracol'said.

Praying doll draws mixed reactions

BOSTON (AP) — A new line of dolls which kneel and clasp their hands in a gesture of prayer has drawn mixed reactions from groups that worry the dolls could inadvertently trivialize religion.

Kenner Parker Toys Inc. says it is marketing the cherubic, 15-inch dolls under the name Special Blessings to capitalize on a growing national interest in traditional values. The dolls will be available on store shelves next month for about \$20.

"Our studies . . . have shown that Americans are turning increasingly to religion and traditional values," David Mauer, president of the company's Kenner division, said in a recent telephone interview.

'When we talked to mothers, they told us they like to see toys

Spokesmen for some religious groups said they saw no harm in such dolls, and others praised the idea. But several expressed wor-

ries "I think it might be wonderful to have a doll that portrays one of the noblest functions of human beings, not killing each other like soldier dolls, but praying," said spokesman Robert P. Dugan of the National Organization of Evangelicals, which represents 70

denominations. In Austin, American Atheists, the largest organization of nonbelievers in the nation, with a 48chapter membership of 60,000, condemned Special Blessings.
