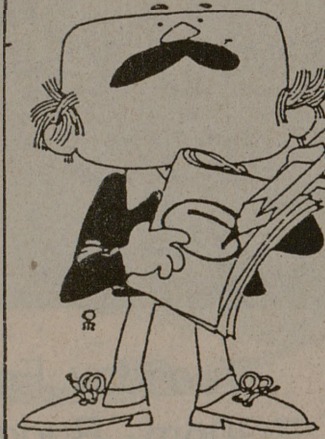

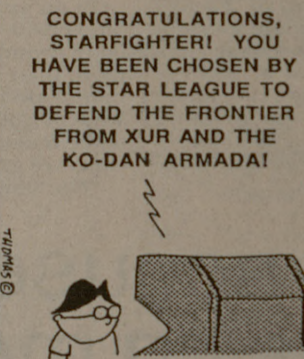

Hostage gives list of demands from Lebanese

BEIRUT, Lebanon (AP) — The kidnappers of a U.S. Marine officer released a videotape Monday in which he recited their demands, including withdrawal by Israel from its border "security zone" in Lebanon.

Lt. Col. William R. Higgins, who appeared to be reading from a text written by his captors, said Reagan "has to take responsibility for the crimes he has committed against the oppressed people in the region."

Higgins was abducted last Wednesday on a highway south of Tyre, an ancient port 50 miles south of Beirut.

A group calling itself the Organization of the Oppressed on Earth, which claimed responsibility for the abduction, released the 70-second tape.

Amal militiamen and troops of the U.N. peacekeeping force in south Lebanon, using dogs, searched the caves and groves of the Tyre area for the sixth day Monday without result.

World Briefs

Memo says Meese knew of payments

WASHINGTON (AP) — A memo to Attorney General Edwin Meese III released Monday said a portion of \$65 million to \$70 million in annual payments to Israel were to go directly to the Israeli Labor Party in connection with an Iraqi pipeline project.

The Sept. 25, 1985, memo, the focal point of a criminal investigation of the attorney general, was written by longtime Meese friend E. Robert Wallach.

Meese has said he does not recall reading the reference in the

document to payments to the Israeli Labor Party headed by Shimon Peres.

The fourth paragraph of the document said Swiss oilman Bruce Rappaport "confirmed the arrangement with Peres" that Israel will receive somewhere between \$65-\$70 million a year for ten years out of the conclusion of the project.

"What was also indicated to me is that a portion of those funds will go directly to Labor," Wallach's memo said.

Citrus growers file suit to stop ban

AUSTIN (AP) — A Florida citrus growers association and a shipper and grower of Florida citrus filed suit in federal court Monday seeking to stop Texas from enforcing its emergency rule to ban the entry of Florida citrus into the state for 30 days.

The suit by the non-profit group, Florida Citrus Mutual, and the Tuxedo Fruit Co. alleged

that Texas' emergency quarantine would cost the Florida citrus industry millions of dollars.

It called Texas' quarantine unconstitutional and invalid.

Texas Agriculture Commissioner Jim Hightower said earlier that the Feb. 15 ban was necessary to prevent citrus canker from coming into Texas.
