



Court indicts market owner for lion attack

HOUSTON (AP) — The owner of the flea market where an 8-year-old girl was mauled by a 300-pound lion last October was indicted on charges of injury to a child.

The indictment, issued Monday by a Harris County grand jury, named The Texas Flea Market and alleged owner James McIngvale as reckless in featuring the lion at a booth where shoppers could pose for photographs with the animal.

McIngvale declined comment on the indictment. The maximum penalty for the felony charge, upon conviction, is a \$50,000 fine.

The owner of the animal, Gary Durkovitz, faces the same charge.

Prosecutor Alice Brown said the flea market should be held as responsible as Durkovitz.

"They invited the lion on the premises and the same culpability lies with them," Brown said.


She said the lion had been an attraction at the north Houston flea market at least twice.

The lion mauled Roxanne Hernandez as Durkovitz and a security guard were leading it on a chain out of the flea market. A security guard shot the lion.

Hernandez suffered serious head injuries when she was mauled by the lion last Oct. 10. She has had five operations and more are expected.

She suffered eight depressed skull fractures, cuts on her scalp and the removal of a section of skull that exposed the brain. Where the bone had been removed, the brain also had been cut.


