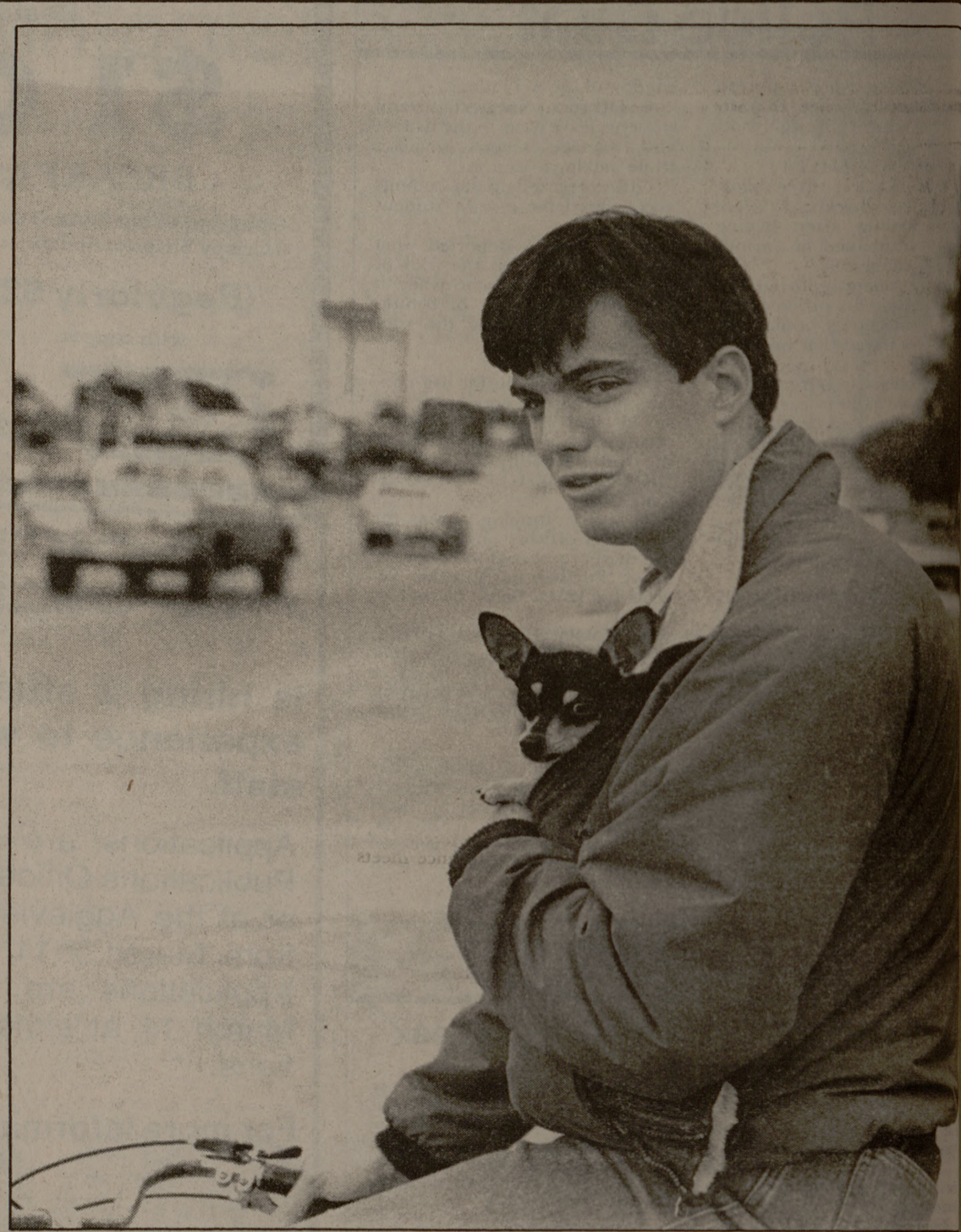

Youths' exposure to asbestos causes overseer to worry

BROWNSVILLE (AP) — The overseer of removal of asbestos from school district buildings said he's worried about children's exposure to the carcinogenic mineral and believes its time to ensure the students' safety.

Tom Keller, deputy superintendent of instructional services with the Brownsville Independent School District, predicted BISSD's asbestos removal program will cost the district approximately \$1.6 million in the next year.

After attending an asbestos abatement training program for the school district, Keller, an avid handyman, realized that the tiles he pried off his floor and the textured paints he used in the past may have contained asbestos.

The fibrous material has been linked with terminal lung cancer and other lung ailments.

"We've all been so exposed," Keller said. "It's dangerous, yes. I have this sick feeling that I've already blown it."

Asbestos fibers can escape into the air and lodge themselves deep in the lungs and remain undetected there for several years before causing any symptoms or problems.

"The older you are, the higher the risk" because of the possibility of prolonged exposure, Keller said.

In October of 1986, President

Reagan signed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act authorizing the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to establish regulations governing the identification, evaluation and control of asbestos-containing materials in private and public schools.

But boxes of building materials have rested in warehouses for years, Keller said, and contractors don't know whether they're purchasing asbestos-free materials.

Keller recommended the district hire teams to start sampling BISSD buildings this summer.

Cost does not matter, he said, because the school district must complete the sampling by October or face fines of \$5,000 per building per day. It also must notify all personnel, students and parents of testing and results.

He figures the district will have to take between 4,000 and 6,000 samples costing \$55 to \$120 each.

Those conducting the sampling must wear special disposable suits costing \$12.50 each and masks that cost \$85 each plus \$6 per disposable filter.

The district has to provide a decontamination unit costing \$14,000, and every time workers remove their suits for any reason, including using the restroom, the district has to provide a new suit.

Actress says she's victim of lawyer

EL PASO (AP) — Actress Tracy Scoggins said she's become a victim again, this time statements made by the lawyer the man accused of trying to sexually assault her.

Pedro Concepcion Padilla, who is accused of attempted sexual assault in the Feb. 25 attack in a hotel elevator, was invited to the hotel by the actress, Padilla's attorney, Jose Montes Jr., said.

Montes said Tuesday that Scoggins invited Padilla to the room after they met in traffic on Interstate 10 that day.

Scoggins told police she got into an elevator alone at the Marriott about 11 p.m., and that the assailant entered the elevator as the doors were about to close. She said the man ripped the front of her dress while the elevator was between floors, then pushed her into the back of the elevator.

She said she fought the man off. Padilla was detained by hotel guests and security and was arrested by El Paso police.

Scoggins described the attack at a news conference the day after, and a first-person account with her byline, is in the latest edition of the *National Enquirer*.

"Tracy Scoggins has turned some very serious charges into very cheap publicity stunt in a desperate attempt to benefit her sagging career," Montes said.
