largest-ever government bailout. The Federal Deposit Insurance Corp., the agency that insures de-posits in commercial banks, hopes to recover all but \$1.7 billion of that by selling its stake in Continental. But nearly four years after the bailout, the FDIC is still the major stockholder in the bank.

Two government moves last week to prop up other large institutions are renewing concerns. The FDIC on Thursday pumped

\$1 billion into First RepublicBank Corp. of Dallas, the nation's 13th largest commercial bank holding company, which has lost nearly \$2 billion in 1988. The agency also \$100,000, and creditors are not protected at all.

When smaller banks fail, as 184 did last year, the FDIC pays off depositors up to the insurance limit or arranges for the accounts to be transferred to a solvent institution.

Big banks, with their extensive ties to other banks, present a more complicated problem. The failure of a arge institution could cause a chain reaction of insolvencies at smaller banks and end up costing the FDIC more than the amount needed to keep the big bank operating. But that logic doesn't make it any

easier for executives who watch their small banks go under while their colleagues at large institutions stay in business.
