

Jury still deliberating in federal sedition trial

FORT SMITH, Ark. (AP) — An all-white jury reached a verdict Wednesday in the trial of five people charged with conspiracy to assassinate two federal officials, but the judge told the jurors to continue their deliberations on two other

Nine of the 13 white supremacists on trial are charged with seditious conspiracy and two are charged with transporting stolen money. The government contends the defendants planned to form an all-white nation in the northwest.

Judge Morris Arnold received the verdict involving an alleged plan to assassinate a federal judge and an FBI agent and told the court clerk not to make it public. The jurors, in a note to Arnold, said they were at a stalemate on the other two counts and a "verdict cannot be reached."

He then told the jury, "I do not intend to discharge the jury at this time after only two days of deliberation after two months of trial.


