



Speaker: Architects' designs in 1 should reflect people's needs rect

Designers and architects often ignore people and their needs when designing buildings, Dr. Brian Net-

tleton said Wednesday In a lecture titled "The Designer's Dilemma: People," Nettleton spoke to an audience of students, faculty and staff members of the College of Architecture and Environmental Design. He addressed the need for architects to consider people when

designing a structure. "If there were no people, there would be no buildings," Nettleton

told his audience. Nettleton said the first question one must ask oneself is whether architects do indeed ignore people. His lecture, accompanied by slides, addressed observations he made regarding this question. Nettleton said there was evidence that architects still ignore people.

He said he once went into the Sterling C. Evans Library and pulled every fifth book dealing with people from the architecture section and did an analysis to see how often the books were borrowed. About 10 percent had actually been borrowed,

There is other evidence of architects not being taught to consider people, he added. He spoke of when he first arrived at Texas A&M and looked at sketches of the interior of the Langford Architecture Center done by more than 40 first-year stu-

'I looked at them all and there was only one sketch that had people in it," Nettleton said. When he asked the student why the sketch had people, Nettleton said the student told him of a professor who said things should be human scale.

'Good man,'I told him," Nettleton said. " '10 out of 10 on the scale for you!' "

In reviewing student designs, questions about how the design would affect those who would use the building are rarely asked, Nettleton explained.
