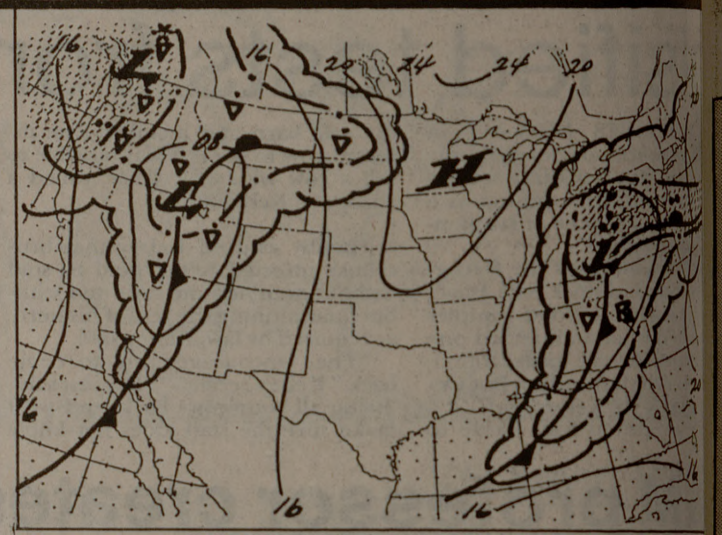

Map Discussion: The upper pattern, which largely dictates the surface features, remains essentially unchanged. The upper low pressure system over the midwest will phase with a short wave trough in the Tennessee Valley resulting in the surface low and front which will produce precipitation from the Appalachians to Southern New England. In the West, an upper low will slowly move to the southeast, with precipitation through the central Rockies and the Pacific Northwest. Meanwhile, Bryan-College Station will enjoy fair weather under the ridge of high pressure from the western Great Lakes to South Texas.

Forecasts:
 Today, tonight and Friday: Fair to partly cloudy with warm days and mild nights. Highs will be in the mid to upper 80s and lows will be in the low to mid 60s. Winds will be southeasterly at five to 12 mph.

Weather Fact: Visibility — The greatest distance at which the observer can see and identify objects with the unaided eye. After visibilities have been determined for the entire horizon circle, they are resolved into a single value of prevailing visibility for reporting purposes.

Insurance plan gives discounts for seat belts

AUSTIN (AP) — A proposal before the State Board of Insurance would give Texas drivers discounts of 15 percent to 30 percent on automobile insurance if their cars have air bags or automatic seat belts.

The proposal was submitted by the Texas Automobile Insurance Service Office, an industry organization.

Only private passenger autos would be eligible for the discount. The 15 percent discount would apply to autos with passive restraints only for the driver, while the 30 percent discount would apply if front-seat passengers also are protected.

"Although the exact amount of the discount will vary according to

the rating territory in which the is garaged, typical savings would be \$5 to \$11 per year on the standard \$2,500 of personal injury protection," John Nance, chairman of service office, said.

Dixie Ewalt, director of research and information services for the insurance board, said it would be to six weeks before the staff completes an analysis of the proposal and submits it to the board for approval.

Nance said in a statement, "our intent to send a message to manufacturers that the public is the kind of protection afforded both air bags and automatic belts."

Campus investigates destruction of nests

ODESSA (AP) — School officials grouse that hundreds of swallows' nests on the University of Texas-Permian Basin campus are a nasty nuisance.

But U.S. Fish and Wildlife officials say the birds have a right to nest there and plan to investigate the destruction of nests by UTPB maintenance workers this week.

Workers at UTPB began wrecking hundreds of swallows' nests built recently by the migratory birds beneath overhanging cement structures on the campus' main building.

While it's permissible to destroy incomplete nests, tearing down active ones and breaking eggs violates the Migratory Bird Treaty and is punishable by a \$200 fine or harsher, court-ordered action, Robert Lee, an investigator for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in Lubbock, said.

University spokeswoman Yvonne Harris said Monday that Bruce Revell, UTPB's chief business officer, ordered the destruction of partially-built nests about two weeks ago to

discourage the birds from nesting the school's main building.

Harris said that on one occasion temporary worker knocked down nest that contained eggs.

But workers have been told to destroy only unfinished nests, she said. The nests were destroyed because mud and droppings were deterring the building and causing unsanitary conditions, she said.

But Midland bird rehabilitation Midge Erskine said Monday UTPB students have shown they destroyed nests and broken eggs, causing the destruction of several nests.

"The students told me some of these nests had been up there for more than three weeks," Erskine said, adding that the swallows at UTPB are beneficial animals that should be alone.

"You don't destroy something that's eating tons of mosquitoes," Edwin Kurtz, a UTPB professor of life sciences and chemistry, he opposes wrecking the nests.

"I was very sorry to see it happen, particularly when they are nesting," he said.

High school student gives birth at school

AUSTIN (AP) — A high school senior gave birth to a girl in a Round Rock High School bathroom Tuesday, officials said.

Cheryl Parsons Darnell, director of communications for the Round Rock school district, said the student "asked her teacher if she could go to the restroom and immediately delivered the baby."

Darnell would not identify the student, but said she is 18 and had been prepared to graduate this spring. The mother and baby were taken by ambulance to Round Rock Community Hospital.

"Both mom and baby are doing fine," said Ricky Reed, a paramedic with the Williamson County Emergency Medical Service who responded to the call.

He also declined to release mother's name.

"Apparently, no one knew the student was pregnant," Darnell said. "Apparently, she was overweight."

The student's parents, teachers and fellow students and friends did not know that she was pregnant, Darnell said.

A teacher went to the restroom to assist the young woman after another student reported what was happening, Darnell said.
