H. Ross Perot joins in fight against casinos

GALVESTON (AP) — Dallas billionaire H. Ross Perot has joined in the fight against legalized gambling in Texas, pledging \$10,000 to help defeat a move to establish casinos in this island city.

Perot, who agreed to contribute the money Wednesday, said gambling is a sad joke on the state and he compared it to the deadly disease

The money he pledged will go a group fighting a measure that would legalize gambling casinos by creating casino-district in the Southeast Texas resort city.

"If this happens in Galveston, it could be a disease that goes across the state," Perot said. "It's like AIDS. If you get it anywhere, it can spread."

Voters will go to the polls Aug. 13 in Galveston to decide whether they want area legislators to seek passage of laws that could lead to legalized casino gambling.

The election was scheduled after

the pro-gambling group Galvestoni-Economic Development gathered enough registered voters' ignatures to force the election.

Perot made the donation after Steven Long, hired to represent an-other group, Galvestonians Against Casino Gambling, asked him to contribute to the anti-gambling cam-paign and take a public stand on the

Long told the Dallas businessman that Las Vegas and Atlantic City ca-sino operators pledged to spend \$150,000 to convince Galveston voters that casino gambling will revive the city's sagging economy.

Organizations that won hard-fought anti-gambling majorities in 1984 and 1987 fear they may be outgunned financially the third time around, Long said in a letter to Perot. Anti-gambling forces spent about \$35,000 to defeat a January

1987 legalized gambling proposal. Gambling will not solve the financial woes of Galveston or the state, Perot said Wednesday.

"I believe, as we restructure Texas away from an oil and gas economy to a diversified economy and industrial base, the last thing we need is to try to build a state based on horse racing and casino gambling and dog racing and lotteries," Perot said.

"We'd better get down to basics and create good jobs for our people and do it in the old-fashioned way, through a good educational system and hard work.

president of Dallas-based Pratt Hotel Corp., Jack Pratt, said recently his firm will build a \$150 million casino-hotel in Galveston if such operations are legalized. Las Vegas interests have added

funds to pro-gambling funds along with Galveston's own Central Cities Development Co.
