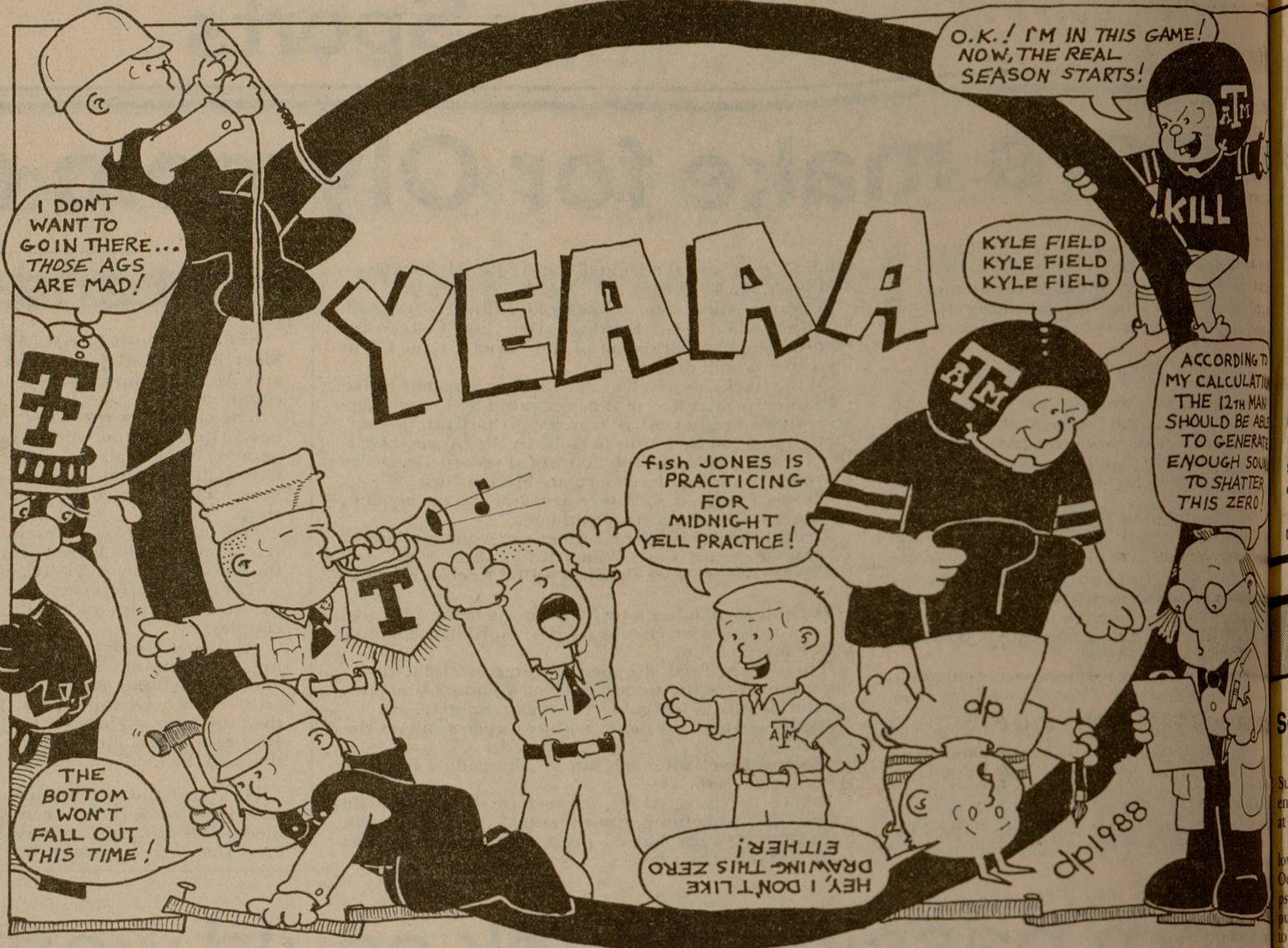

Washington picked to nose out Bruins

(AP) Terry Donahue is the winningest coach in UCLA history (101-36-7—726) and since he took over in 1976 the Bruins have been anything but a .500 team — except when they visit Seattle or play a Pac-10 opener.
 Washington coach Don James and Donahue are both closing in on former Southern California coach John McKay's conference coaching record of 70 league wins.
 Donahue faces both of these problems Saturday when second-ranked UCLA meets No. 16 Washington. Donahue's Bruins are 2-2-1 in Husky Stadium and only 5-5-2 in conference openers.
 Want more? In the last six-plus seasons, UCLA is 0-2-1 in Seattle.
 UCLA had last week off while Washington blew a 28-0 lead against San Jose State and had to rally to win 35-31.

Bluebonnet gets time to search for sponsor

HOUSTON (AP) — The president of the financially strapped Bluebonnet Bowl is appealing for a sponsor to keep the 29-year-old college football game alive.
 The NCAA Post-Season Subcommittee extended an August deadline to Oct. 9 for bowl officials to find a sponsor and pay off \$400,000 in debts to former participants. The August deadline was set after bowl officials failed to meet a July deadline.
 Bowl President Al Warrington says his committee is still discussing possible sponsorships with a few corporations and individuals, but no firm commitments have been received.
 "This bowl really has become an institution," Warrington said. "It has created a tremendous amount of positive national publicity for the city of Houston, has contributed millions to both participating schools and charities it has supported, and has annually been among the biggest single events tourism-wise for the city of Houston."
 "The bottom line is it would be a tragedy to see this institution disappear after so many years."
 The Oct. 9 deadline is the one that will decide the bowl's fate. The \$400,000 is needed to play a game this December at the Astrodome.
 A \$1 million letter of credit reportedly was required by the NCAA.
 According to Warrington, the committee said if they could not find a sponsor by Oct. 9, the bowl would be canceled. The NCAA requires bowls to pay each participant a minimum of \$500,000.
 "To make this happen, we need a corporate sponsor," Warrington said. "If we have a title sponsor by Oct. 9, we will not have a game this year."
 The bowl also owes \$200,000 to the Houston Sports Association.
