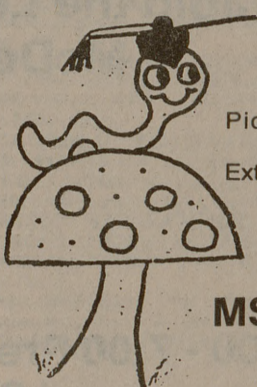

**Police suspect landlady of killing 8**

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) - Police found a fifth corpse Sunday in the yard of a tree-shed in a boardinghouse and for the 71-year-old landlady suspected of killing the elderly and cashing their Social Security checks.  
Investigators said they found seven or eight bodies may be buried in the yard, based on a number of residents who reported seeing a man in a dingy house manager Donalberto Puentes for questioning. Sgt. Bob Burns said.  
A resident of the rooming house John McCauley, 59, was Sunday for investigation of an accessory to homicide. Authorities said they helped Puentes dig the graves of the victims.  
"We do not believe that have been done solely by Enloe said. "We know she help her dig the holes."  
Puentes, who is on parole for a 1982 conviction for drug robbery three people, was viewed by police after the body was discovered Friday but for lack of evidence.  
The woman apparently cashing some of the victims Security checks for several Enloe said. He said the mother of 100slayings was believed robbery.  
Authorities cordoned off the story home and yard while with picks, shovels and a mover excavated the ground for more corpses. The body was found about noon wrapped in a sheet in a grave near a driveway.  
Earlier, police had said the bodies found Friday and Saturday showed "no overt signs of poisoning."  
At least one of the bodies woman "wrapped like a man a tablecloth, had been buried April, investigators said.  
An all-points bulletin was for Puentes, and she remained large Sunday. She has not charged with the crime, but said an arrest warrant was prepared against her for investigation of murder.  
Authorities were attempting identify the remains.  
Neighbors said they had not complained of a stench the grounds, and were told the emulsion had been used there fertilizer, police said.  
"The first time was about the middle of last May," neighbor Vintire said. "We couldn't smell anything definitely was something dead had a sweet sickly smell."

**Baltic states show benefits of reform**

MOSCOW (AP) - Three republics on the Soviet Union's eastern fringe are showing Mikhail Gorbachev's Kremlin the benefits of its new reform policies, but also dangers of loosened central control and greater local initiative.  
After the 1939 Hitler-Stalin pact decided control over Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania to the Kremlin, Russians kept a tight grip on the three mini-states along the Baltic Sea.  
But President Gorbachev's Communist Party chief since 1985, is promoting more local autonomy in a bid to revive the sagging national economy.  
Moscow's relaxed embrace of greater tolerance for local initiative and opinion may have let the republics out of the bottle in the national prickle Baltics, with unforeseen consequences for the multi-republics and for the multi-nation as a whole.  
"We have been reduced to the level of slaves in a manner," Estonian, Enno Petts, said during Gorbachev's organizational meeting of the People's Front.  
The People's Front is an independent group seeking more autonomy over their own affairs.  
As a sign of Kremlin concern, rising disaffection in the Baltic three members of the ruling Politburo flew there last week.  
In remarks reported by Soviet media, they promised increased economic and cultural autonomy, ruled out any restoration of independence.  
The Baltic states lost their independence in 1940 when the Army marched in.  
Politburo member Viktor M. Brikov told Estonians, "It is possible to receive independence and everything else."  
Growing clamor in the Baltics focused on Gorbachev's blueprint for political change.  
Activists say the changes will null their republics' right to self-determination now recognized in theory by the 1977 Soviet Constitution - and economic and social control over
