



HOUSTON (AP) — A Houston firm has entered a joint venture to market outer-space scientific serv

Space Commerce Corp. will handle public relations activities on behalf of the Soviets, market Soviet satellites and provide engineering and technical services, the *Houston*U.S. observers have said it might take as many as 18 shuttle missions just in the first phase, to put the technical services, the Houston Chronicle reported Tuesday. "They make it, we sell it," Arthur

M. Dula, Space Commerce president, said Tuesday.

"It doesn't have a dollar value," he said. "We're both contributing and we'll split the profits."

Dula said the company will be getting a better understanding of what whether an American company is the Soviets have to sell. "I don't going to work with them to make" know what bits and pieces they real. make. There's going to be a large flow of information to us so we can

sell these services.' Dula said the contract includes marketing and sale of the new —and up to now secret - satellite-borne

Known in the international space community for his rapport with the Soviets, and his salesmanship abilities, Dula is kicking off the new venture with a highly unusual offer.

He wants to launch America's space station, Freedom, now in its design and development stage, on the giant Soviet rocket Energia, the world's mightiest rocket, sometime 5:30 p.m. Monday, police said. in the 1990s.

"It would save the American tax-payers about \$5 billion," he said.


