



Texas space company makes deal with USSR

HOUSTON (AP) — A Houston firm has entered a joint venture to market outer-space scientific services, data and hardware for the Soviet Union, the company's president said.
Space Commerce Corp. will handle public relations activities on behalf of the Soviets, market Soviet satellites and provide engineering and technical services, the *Houston Chronicle* reported Tuesday.
"They make it, we sell it," Arthur M. Dula, Space Commerce president, said Tuesday.
"It doesn't have a dollar value," he said. "We're both contributing and we'll split the profits."
Dula said the company will be getting a better understanding of what the Soviets have to sell. "I don't know what bits and pieces they make. There's going to be a large flow of information to us so we can sell these services."
Dula said the contract includes marketing and sale of the new — and up to now secret — satellite-borne nuclear reactor.
Dula signed the contract with Glavcosmos, the civilian Soviet space agency, in New York on Dec. 19. It became official Jan. 4 when Alexander E. Dunayev, head of Glavcosmos, signed it in Moscow.
Known in the international space community for his rapport with the Soviets, and his salesmanship abilities, Dula is kicking off the new venture with a highly unusual offer.

Boy drowns in cesspool in El Paso

EL PASO (AP) — A 14-month-old boy drowned in an uncovered cesspool at his home in east El Paso, officials said.
Arturo Morales was discovered in the cesspool about an hour after his parents reported him missing about 5:30 p.m. Monday, police said.
The boy's head and upper body were submerged in about 2 feet of liquid, police Sgt. Robert Almonte said.
The boy fell into a hole about 14 inches square.
Although police called the receptacle a cesspool, it was unclear whether it was a cesspool, which is illegal in El Paso County, or a legal septic tank.
