

### A&M rugby team competes in Mardi Gras tourney

The Texas A&M men's rugby team participated in the Mardi Gras Tournament in Baton Rouge, La. last weekend.

The Aggies opened the tournament with a 12-4 loss to Rhodes College of Memphis, Tenn. John Beard scored for A&M.

Then the Aggies pounded Roger Williams College from

Rhode Island 18-4. Marty Paris, James Goodman and Scott Krippner all scored for A&M.

The Aggies made it two wins in a row when they dealt Stephen F. Austin a 12-9 loss.

In the consolation championship, the University of Kentucky defeated A&M 3-0.

also make an impact on the team, especially against SWC opponents. The senior hit .311 in conference games last year.

Johnson said much of the hitting power of last year's record 80-homerun season should be present again this year. A&M will need consistency at the plate to overcome the other SWC teams.

Second baseman Terry Taylor, who led A&M with 17 homers last year, is confident the Aggies will have some cannons.

"We have power throughout the lineup," he said. "I think the two-through-six place hitters will be close to double figures in homers."

The guns on the mound this season are mostly young and inexperienced. Randy Pryor and Scott Centala should be called on most often. As a starter, Pryor worked more innings last year than any other A&M pitcher, carrying an 8-4 record and a 3.08 earned-run average.

Centala was the ace reliever with a 5-1 record and a team-leading 11

saves. Johnson is expected to be Centala as a reliever again this season.

Only four of the 13 other Aggie pitchers lettered at A&M last year, which leaves Johnson not knowing what to expect.

"There are a lot of question marks involving the young staff," Centala said. "But I think the talent will overcome the lack of experience."

A highlight of the season for Aggies will be April 14-16 when Texas pays a visit to Olsen Field. The third game of the series will be televised by ESPN.

If the Aggies finish in the top spots in the conference, they will host the SWC tournament at Olsen Field May 17-20. The next would be the NCAA Regional. Johnson said the team's loss to State-Fullerton in the final of last year's South Regional is giving players initiative to try again.

"It's always encouraging when you can go that far," he said. "It's no longer a distant dream — it's fresh in their minds."
