## Stewart likes Tigers' chances

DALLAS (AP) — Unless the television picture was playing tricks, Norm Stewart believes he sees the Missouri Tigers' confidence growing enough to get revenge on Syracuse Friday in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinals.

Stewart, who is recovering from cancer surgery, said some of the best medicine he received was the Tigers' 108-89 victory over Texas Sunday.

"Now that I've had a little time, feel a little stronger, it's fun to watch the games," he said by telephone from his home in Columbia to radio station KCMO in Kansas City.

"Now that they've gotten a couple

of wins under their belt in the NCAA, they know they can play with anybody," said Stewart, who has frequently talked with interim coach Rich Daly by telephone.

Sixth-ranked Missouri (29-7) suffered an 86-84 overtime loss to No. 7 Syracuse in the Big Apple NIT final earlier this season.

Syracuse coach Jim Boeheim agreed with Stewart that the Tigers are more dangerous than they were early in the season.

"Missouri's a veteran, solid team and very improved from when we played earlier," he said.

Colorado State coach Boyd Grant picks Syracuse to win again.

"Missouri has the athletes who can play with Syracuse, but if Derrin Coleman is well, I can see Syracuse in the Final Four," Grant said.

Coleman, who sat out a first round game against Bucknell because of a back injury, scored 12 points and had seven rebounds and two blocks against Colorado State.

Missouri showed inside muscle against Texas, outrebounding the Longhorns 41-30.

Missouri also held the Longhorns three-point shooting to 5 of 17.
