tact with Slocum, said he also likes linebacker Aaron Wallace's chances for national recognition.

"There's very few in that (Heisman) category," he said. "And Wallace has a chance to be in the first three picks next year."

Besides Sherrill's exodus from the A&M coaching staff, several Aggie assistants have found new positions in college football.

The Longhorns recently landed A&M assistant Bob Boyd to coach tight ends, while the big conference news centered on former A&M offensive guru Lynn Amedee's return to Texas, this time to coordinate the offense of the Longhorns.

Sherrill reflected on the Amedee era at A&M, squelching any rumors there was ever any animosity between the two.

"Lynn is a good football coach," Sherrill said. "He did everything I asked him to do. You would tell him what you wanted to do, and he'd go do it."

"Things in Florida just didn't turn out like he anticipated. Texas still has that magic name. But people outside the state of Texas couldn't tell you how Texas has played the last four or five years."

For now, Sherrill can only talk about the SWC as an outsider looking in. He said he is content to live in College Station and weigh his career options as they surface.

"It's a nice place and a great place to raise kids. I'm just looking at different things. I just want to make the right decision," Sherrill said.

Illinois to play Southern Cal in Moscow

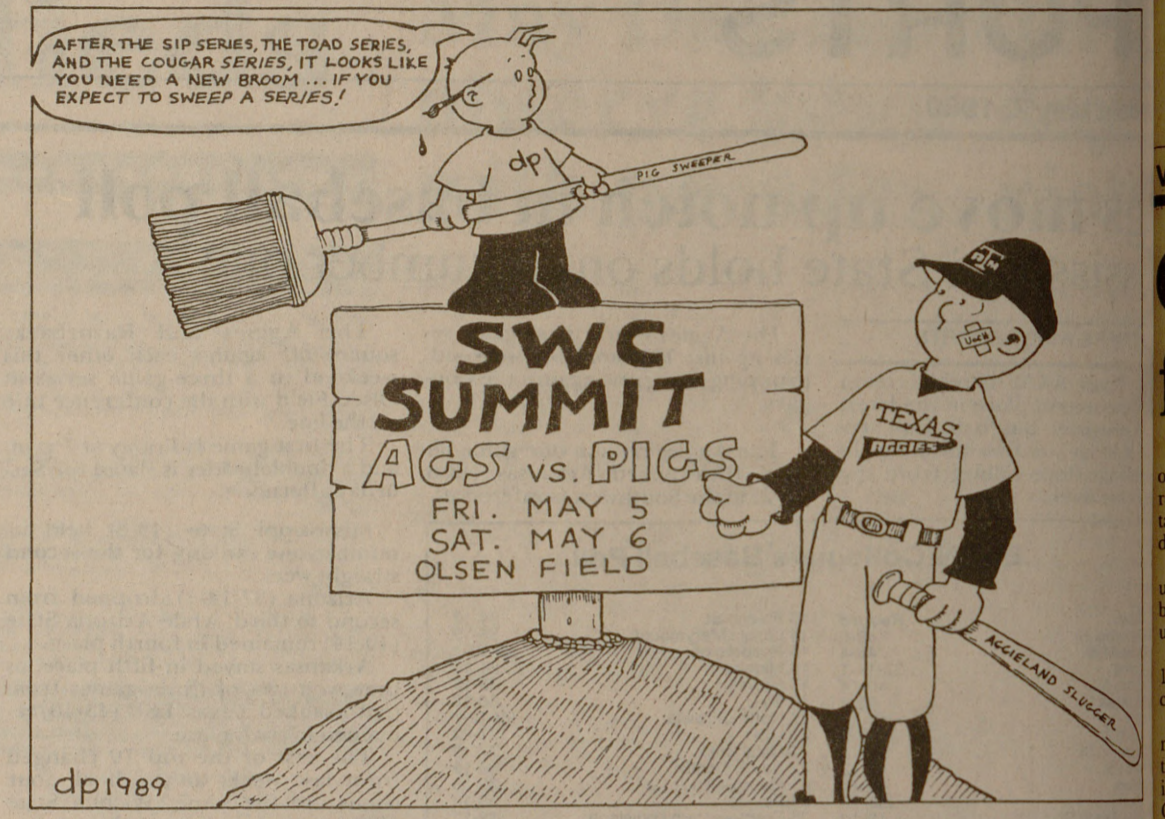
MOSCOW (AP) — A football game between Illinois and Southern California universities will take place Sept. 2 in Moscow in the first such match in the Soviet Union, *Tass* said Friday.

A contract was signed last week between the U.S. sponsor and the Soviet economic group Sovintersport.

It was signed to pave the way for the historic match dubbed "Glasnost Cup," the official news agency said.

"To bring so many Americans and to present their favorite sport, is it not a step toward mutual understanding?" *Tass* quoted Kenneth Haines, a representative of the sponsoring firm Raycom, as saying.

"This publicity will only help our company," Haines said.



Carlesimo to stay with Seton Hall

SOUTH ORANGE, N.J. (AP) — Despite overtures from Kentucky, Seton Hall basketball coach P.J. Carlesimo ended a week of soul-searching Monday by deciding to stay at the school he took to the NCAA championship game.

"The strong desire that I have to continue this relationship would not allow me to leave Seton Hall," Carlesimo said. "I am extremely comfortable living in the (New York) metropolitan area, competing in the Big East, and I am certain no other environment would be as attractive to me."

The Associated Press initially reported that day that Carlesimo would accept the Kentucky job, but not until he talked to Seton Hall officials.

On Friday, however, one of the sources who was quoted in the original report said Carlesimo seemed to be having second thoughts about the job.

The same source also said Carlesimo never definitely accepted the job and it never formally was offered to him.

In ending talks with Kentucky, Carlesimo remained loyal to the school that stuck by him when fans were calling for his resignation.

The 39-year-old coach also turned down the opportunity for a job that pays about \$600,000 a year and is one of the most prestigious in college basketball.

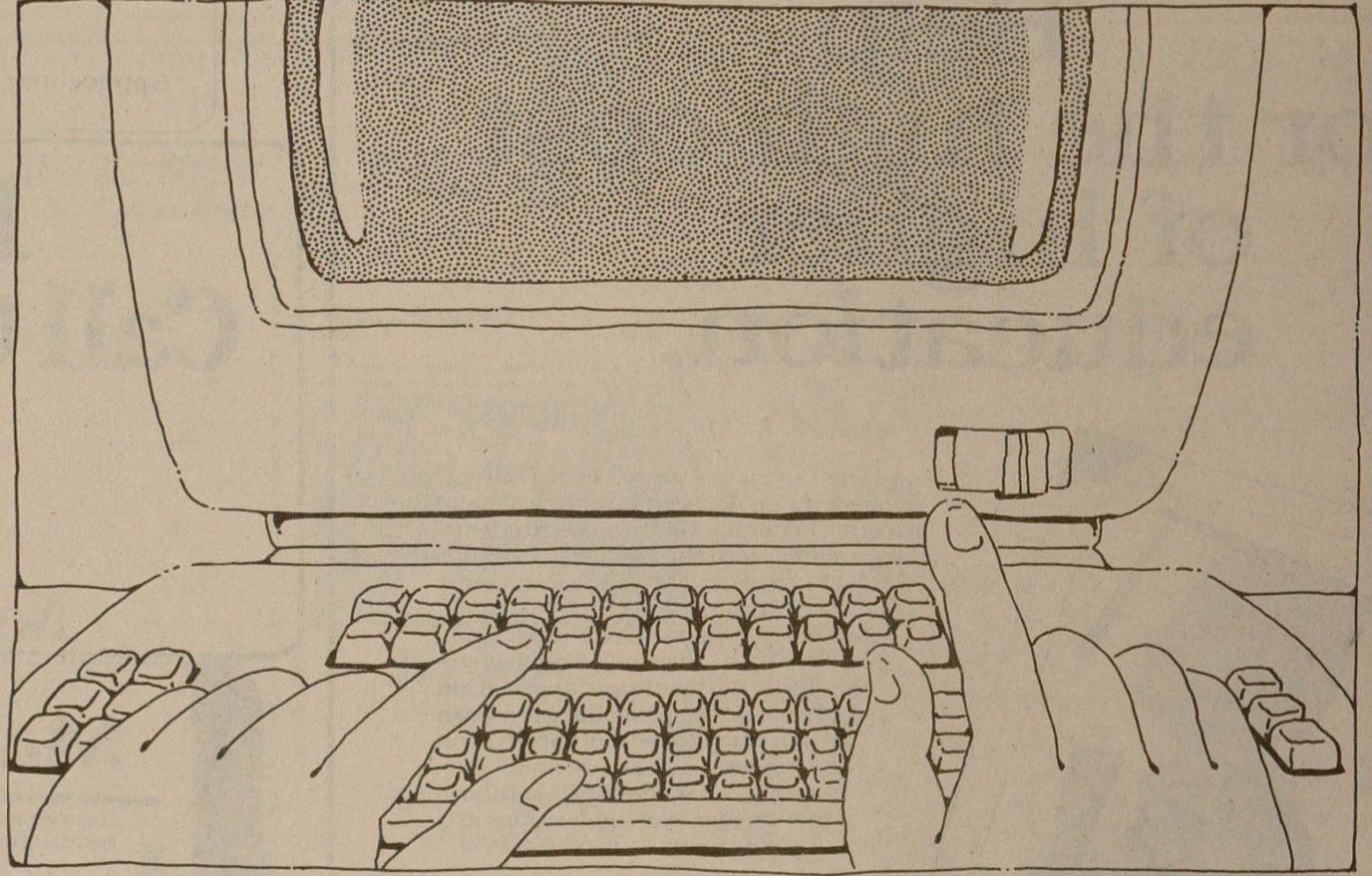
Carlesimo guided Seton Hall within one point of a national championship last month, losing to Michigan 80-79 in overtime. The '77 season was the Pirates' best since 1952-53, and Carlesimo earned the second straight Big East Coach of the Year award.

The turnaround in the Seton Hall program came a little more than a year after the school's student government called for Carlesimo's ouster.
