## Fort Bend turns inmate away for fear of infection

HOUSTON (AP) — A Harris County Jail inmate facing another charge in nearby Fort Bend County isn't welcome at the jail there because authorities are concerned he might be sick with a bacterial infection, a prosecutor said Thursday.

A bacterial infection called pneumococcus disease has killed two Harris County Jail inmates and stricken several others in the crowded facility. Health officials Thursday were treating and vaccinating those inmates at risk of contracting the infection.

Timothy Lee Thomas, 18, was booked into the Harris County Jail last month. Officials were ready to release him on bond Wednesday, but they were unable to do so because Fort Bend County has a hold on him for an alleged offense committed there.

Generally, that would result in a routine transfer from one jail to the other, but Fort Bend officials have nixed that action because they fear the inmate might have the infection and spread it to their jail.

"The whole point of this is that we just don't know what their status is there," Frank Follis, first assistant district attorney in Fort Bend County, said.

"It didn't seem like a good idea to bring him here," Follis said Thursday.

"I understand he is sick — I don't know what he's sick with," Follis said, noting that family members have

talked about Thomas being ill.

Thomas is accused of violating probation on a misdemeanor assault in Fort Bend County after being arrested in Houston for allegedly selling a \$20 rock of crack cocaine.

A judge approved a pre-trial release bond for Thomas on the drug delivery case, but Follis said he doesn't believe the inmate should be released on a personal recognizance bond in Fort Bend County to await hearing on the alleged probation violation.

Follis said he plans to discuss the case with a judge, who will have

decide what kind of bond, if any, should be set for Thomas. But in the meantime, Thomas isn't wanted in the Fort Bend County Jail with about 300 inmates are housed.

"We don't want to get our jail inmates exposed to a possibly contagious disease," Follis said.

If a Fort Bend County judge sets bond for Thomas, and he posts it, then would be out of jail pending both cases, Follis said.


