AUSTIN (AP) — The presiding judge in the 15-year-old lawsuit over the state mental health system suggested Thursday the case might never end if the Legislature doesn't appropriate money to solve ongoing problems.

In an order issued by U.S. District Judge Barefoot Sanders of Dallas, the state was given a schedule for making numerous im-

Calling those deadlines "feasible targets," Sanders said compliance would end litigation begun in 1974 against the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation.

The judge cited progress in many areas. "However," he wrote, "it appears from the history of this case that defendants have never

been provided sufficient funds for complete compliance. Unless provided adequate funds by the Legislature, defendants will never achieve compliance, and this lawsuit will never

The order in the so-called R.A.J. case noted that MHMR officials sought \$105 million from the Legislature in the 1990-91 budget to comply with court orders but got only \$60 mil-

MHMR officials asked Gov. Bill Clements to add mental health funds to the agenda of the June-July special session, but Sanders noted that it wasn't included.

Clements' press secretary, Rossanna Salazar, said the governor's staff would review the

order and had no immediate comment whether MHMR funds would be include the special session convening Nov. 14.
